DOC ID	Offender's Dept of Corrections Number
First Name	Offender's DOC First Name
Middle Name	Offender's DOC Middle Name
Last Name	Offender's DOC Last Name
Generation/Suffix	Offender's DOC Generation/Suffix
Date of Birth	Offender's DOC Date of Birth: Verified (V) type if exists, if no Verified, then Unverified (U) if it exists, if no Verified or Unverified then first Alias (A) type found.
SSN	Offender' DOC Social Security Number: Verified (V) type if exists, if no Verified then Unverified (U) if it exists, if no Verified or Unverified then first Alias (A) type found.
SSN verification flag	Flag indicating whether DOC SSN has been verified by SSA
Assigned Place	Offender's DOC Assigned Location Acronym
Incident Date	The Date the Incident Occurred (DOC)
Minimum Release Date	The Minimum Date the Offender can be Released (DOC)
Release Date	The Offender's Release Date (DOC)
DCN	Children's Division Department Client Number of the Parent
Case ID	Children's Division Case Number
FCS Address 1	Children's Division Primary Household Address
FCS Address 2	Children's Division-adds additional information about the address
City	Children's Division Household City

FCS refers to Family-Centered Services. These are intact families.

AC refers to Alternative Care. These are children in CD custody.

## **DEFINITIONS OF FIELDS ON MATCHED REPORT**

IIS refers to Intensive In-Home Services. This is an intensive program which provides services to families with children at risk of removal from the home.

CA/N refers to a child abuse and neglect hotline report.

Roles-There are several different roles that a person may hold: Parent, Child, Child Caretaker, Significant Other, Absent Parent, and Other.
