

**13 CSR 40-19.030 Summer Electric Utility Service.** This rule established the requirements to qualify for a summer energy assistance program in 1981.

**COPY**

*PURPOSE: This rule is being rescinded because it applies only to a program that expired in 1981.*

*AUTHORITY: section 207.022, RSMo. 2015. Emergency rule filed Dec. 15, 1980, effective Dec. 15, 1980, expired March 11, 1981. Original rule filed Dec. 5, 1980, effective March 12, 1981. Original authority: 207.020, RSMo 1945, amended 1961, 1965, 1977, 1981, 1982, 1986, 1993, 1994.*

*PUBLIC COST: This proposed rescission will not cost state agencies or political subdivisions more than five hundred dollars (\$500) in the aggregate.*

*PRIVATE COST: This proposed rescission will not cost private entities more than five hundred dollars (\$500) in the aggregate.*
