**NOTICE TO MEDICAL ASSISTANCE RECIPIENTS WITH SHELTERED
WORKSHOP INCOME**

Effective September 1, 2007, the income you earn from Sheltered Workshop employment will no longer be counted as income for your Medical Assistance. This means your Medical Assistance Spenddown amount will be lower for September 2007 or you will receive Medical Assistance without meeting a spenddown. If you continue to be a spenddown, the decrease will show on the next invoice you receive. This will be your September 2007 invoice that is mailed the first of August. If you agree with the above decision, you do not have to request a hearing.

If you feel this action is wrong, you have the right to request a hearing within 90 days of the date of this letter. You may request a hearing by mail, by telephone, or in person through your local Family Support Division office. At the hearing, you may present your information yourself or you may be represented by your own attorney or by other persons who know your situation. If you do not have an attorney, or cannot afford one, you may be able to get help from Legal Aid or Legal Services in your area. You have the right to bring witnesses to testify at the hearing and to question witnesses who appear at the request of the Family Support Division.
