Requirements for the Behavioral Health Consultant Certification Renewal

- > The clinician must maintain their Professional Licensure, e.g., LCSW, Psy.D., Ph.D.
- The clinician must meet continuing education requirements of 14 hours during the <u>2 year</u> certification period. Continuing education may be obtained in the following manner:
 - 8 clock hours of relevant BHC training received during the years in which the certification was active. Proof should be remitted to St. Louis Behavioral Medicine Institute Integrated Care Consulting team.
 - These training hours may be obtained through webinars, online training modules, or live workshops/conferences. Examples of relevant training topics include, but are not limited to:
 - Clinical Behavioral Health Consultant training
 - Systems integration
 - Patient-centered medical home
 - Evidence-based treatment and models of care for chronic medical conditions
 - Brief evidence-based practices for mental health and substance abuse
 - BHC ethics in primary care/medical settings
 - Billing and sustainability of primary behavioral health care models
 - Self-management of chronic conditions
 - 6 clock hours of practice/case consultation, via Missouri BHC Regional Meetings presented by St. Louis Behavioral Medicine Institute, as available.
- The clinician is responsible for submitting a copy of the Certification Renewal to the MMAC Provider Enrollment Unit (PEU) as applicable.
