Missouri Family First Workgroup PRTF Rate Model Based On Occupational Wage Data and Missouri Cost Report Data

The prospective Missouri Private PRTF Per-diem rate was created using a wage rate model which utilized data derived from cost surveys prepared and submitted by potential PRTF providers. These cost surveys were collected February, 2021 or prior. The model specifically examines potential facility; occupancy, staff to patient ratios, necessary nursing hours per patient day, direct care and behavioral health professional wage and overhead expense, and risk factors.
