



## Provider Webinar Training for Presumptive Eligibility May 2016

### Description

The Family Support Division (FSD) and the MO HealthNet Division (MHD) are offering a provider training for Presumptive Eligibility (PE). FSD will be training providers on the requirements associated with issuing PE to MO participants. MHD will be available for billing questions.

This is an interactive, web-based training offered to providers, who make Presumptive Eligibility for Children (PC) and Presumptive Eligibility for Pregnant Women determinations. The PE for Pregnant Women training also includes training for the Show Me Healthy Babies Presumptive Eligibility (SMHB-PE) program.

The trainings are limited to one hour in length and offered to individuals or groups. If you intend to use a speaker telephone, ensure that there is minimal background noise and conversation. The provider must have access to the Internet and a telephone.

FSD will issue a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) for each individual provider who will be issuing Presumptive Eligibility. In order to make the PE determinations, each provider must have a signed MOA to determine PE for Pregnant Women or PC. FSD does not want providers to train their own staff. FSD is requiring each staff member who will issue the PE determinations at each individual provider to attend this training. ### Training includes:

- Eligibility criteria;
- Forms used and how to complete them;
- How to make a PE determination; and
- How to process PE requests.

### Requirements prior to training:

- Provider must have a MO HealthNet provider number;
- Be a Qualified Entity;
- Provider must have signed MOA for each of the following PE categories: PC or TEMP.
