Part I

Intensive In-home Services Statewide Overview

Introduction

What is IIS?

Intensive In-home Services (IIS) is a program administered by the Division of Family Services to provide short-term, crisis intervention services to Missouri families.

Who is eligible for IIS?

A family who has a child or children at imminent risk of removal from the home due to abuse, neglect, juvenile delinquency, or other such circumstances are eligible to receive IIS. Intensive home-based services are designed to meet each family's unique needs so that the family can remain safely together. A trained principle specialist, either a DFS employee or a contracted service provider, is assigned to each family to provide services such as individual and family counseling, parenting education, or child development training. The goal of these services is to manage the crisis and restore the family to an acceptable level of functioning.

Who are at-risk children?

The children identified as at-risk for out-of-home placement are referred to as *at-risk children*. During state fiscal year 2002 (July 1, 2001-June 30, 2002), the number of at-risk children accepted into IIS was 3,332. The total number of families accepted into IIS was 1,610 and the total number of children, including at-risk children, was 4,181. On average, families accepted into IIS were comprised of 2.6 total children and 2.1 at-risk children (Appendix A).

Families and Children Not Accepted

A total of 1,230 families including 2,194 at-risk children were referred for IIS during FY 2002 but were not accepted into the program (Appendices A and B). The most common reason (34%) that at-risk children were not accepted into IIS was due to lack of openings into the program with the children remaining at home.

Referral Source of Families

Referrals to IIS are more likely to come from DFS (81%) than any other referral source (Appendix C).

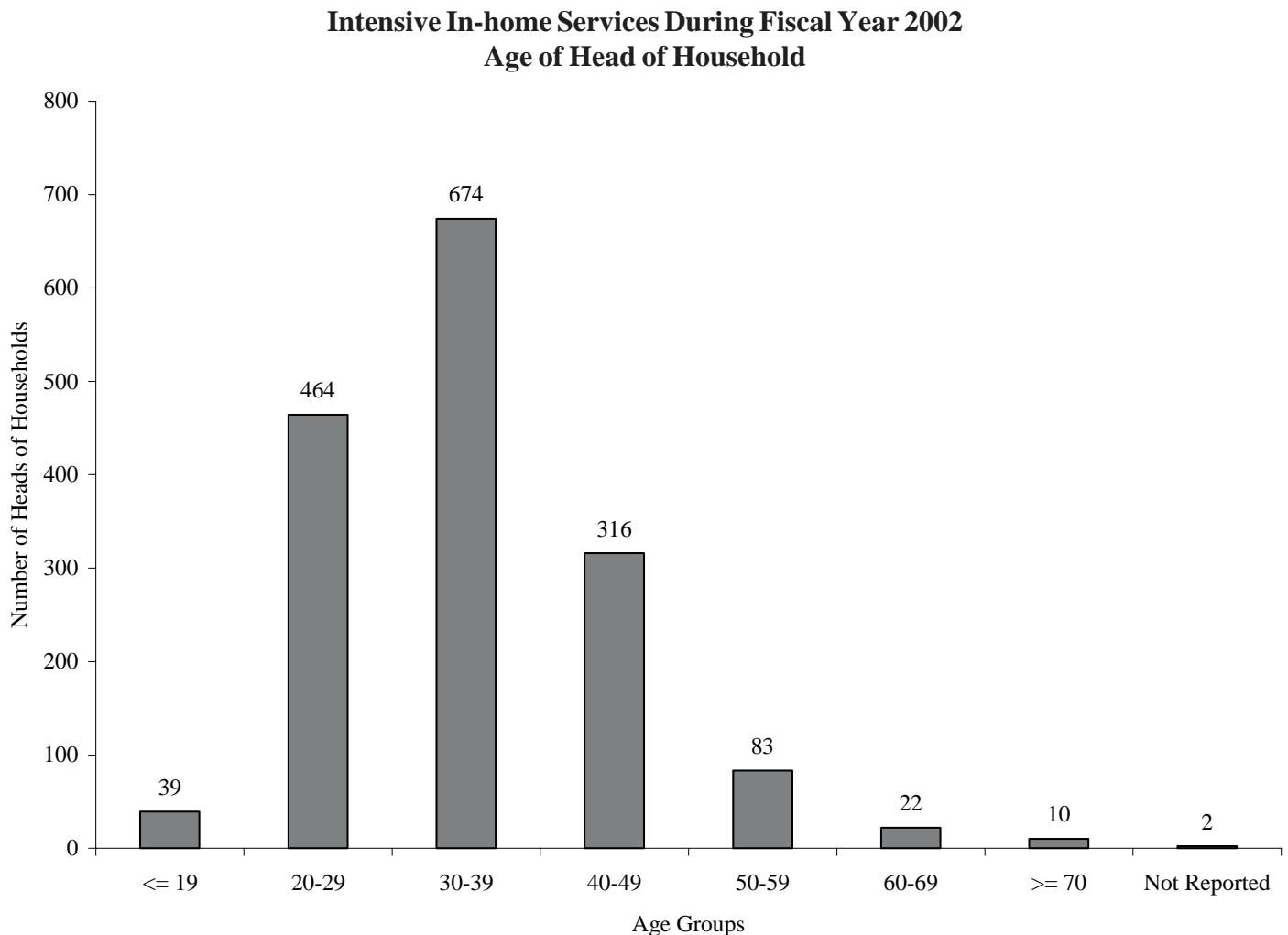

Head of Household Characteristics of Families Accepted

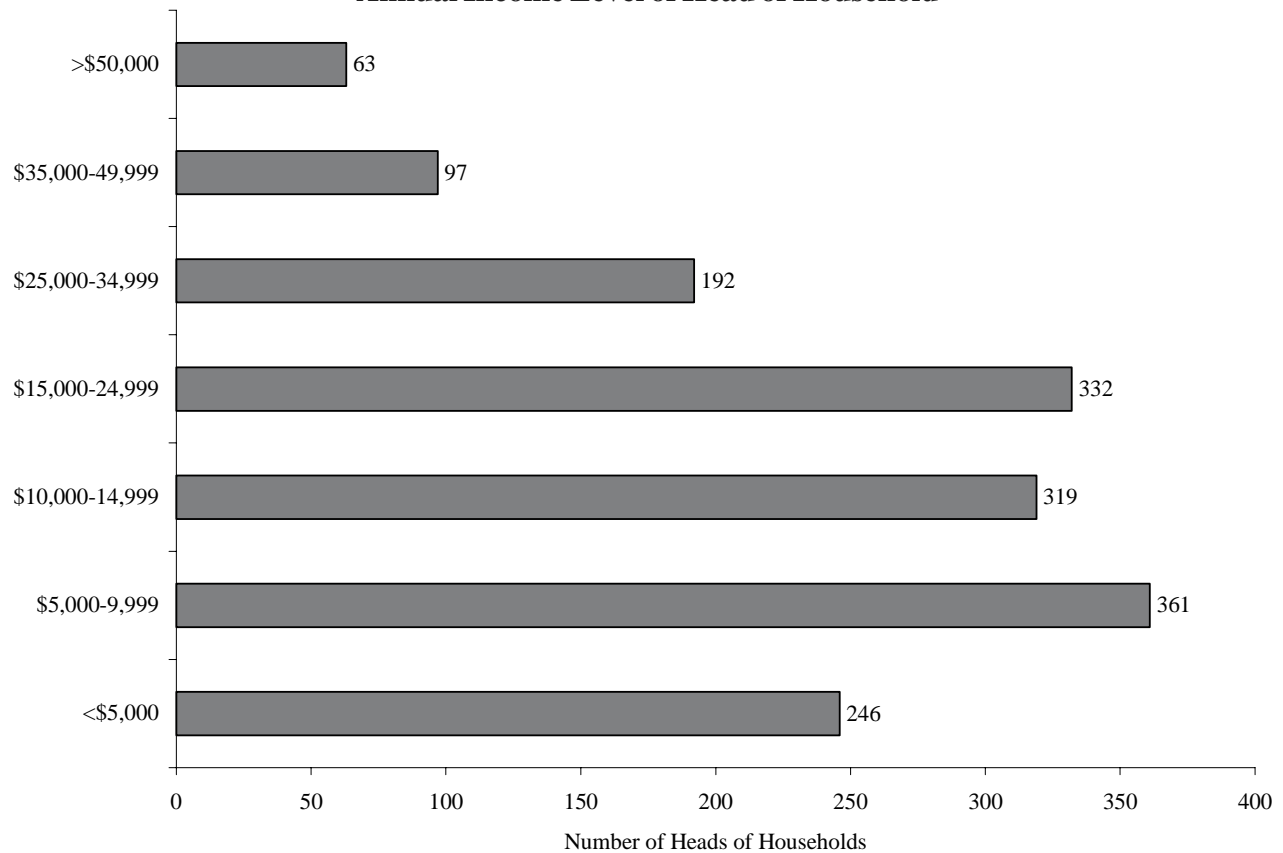

Head of Household Characteristics of Families Accepted (continued)

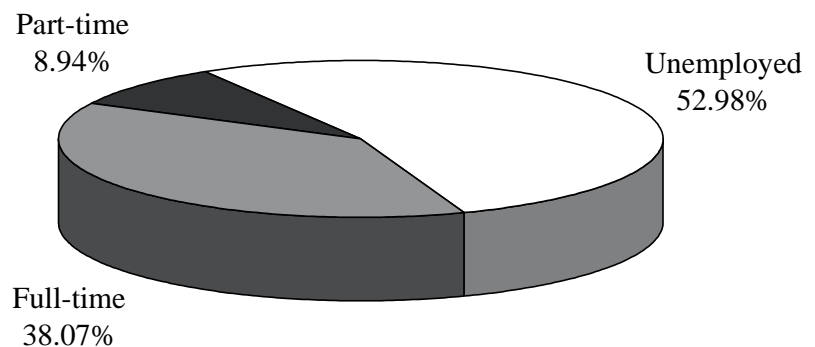
Intensive In-home Services During Fiscal Year 2002 Annual Income Level of Head of Household



Fifty-eight percent of the heads of households earned incomes of less than \$15,000 as compared to 33 percent with incomes in the \$15,000 to \$35,000 range (Appendix H).

Intensive In-home Services During Fiscal Year 2002 Employment Status of Head of Household

Sixty-two percent of heads of households were either unemployed or employed part-time, while 38% were employed full-time (Appendix G).



Head of Household Characteristics of Families Accepted (continued)

Almost 63 percent of the 1,610 heads of households required help with parenting skills problems during FY 2002. The next most frequently addressed head of household problem was parent/child conflict at 45 percent (721) followed by communication at 30 percent (483), child neglect at 23 percent (371), and physical abuse at 19 percent (310).

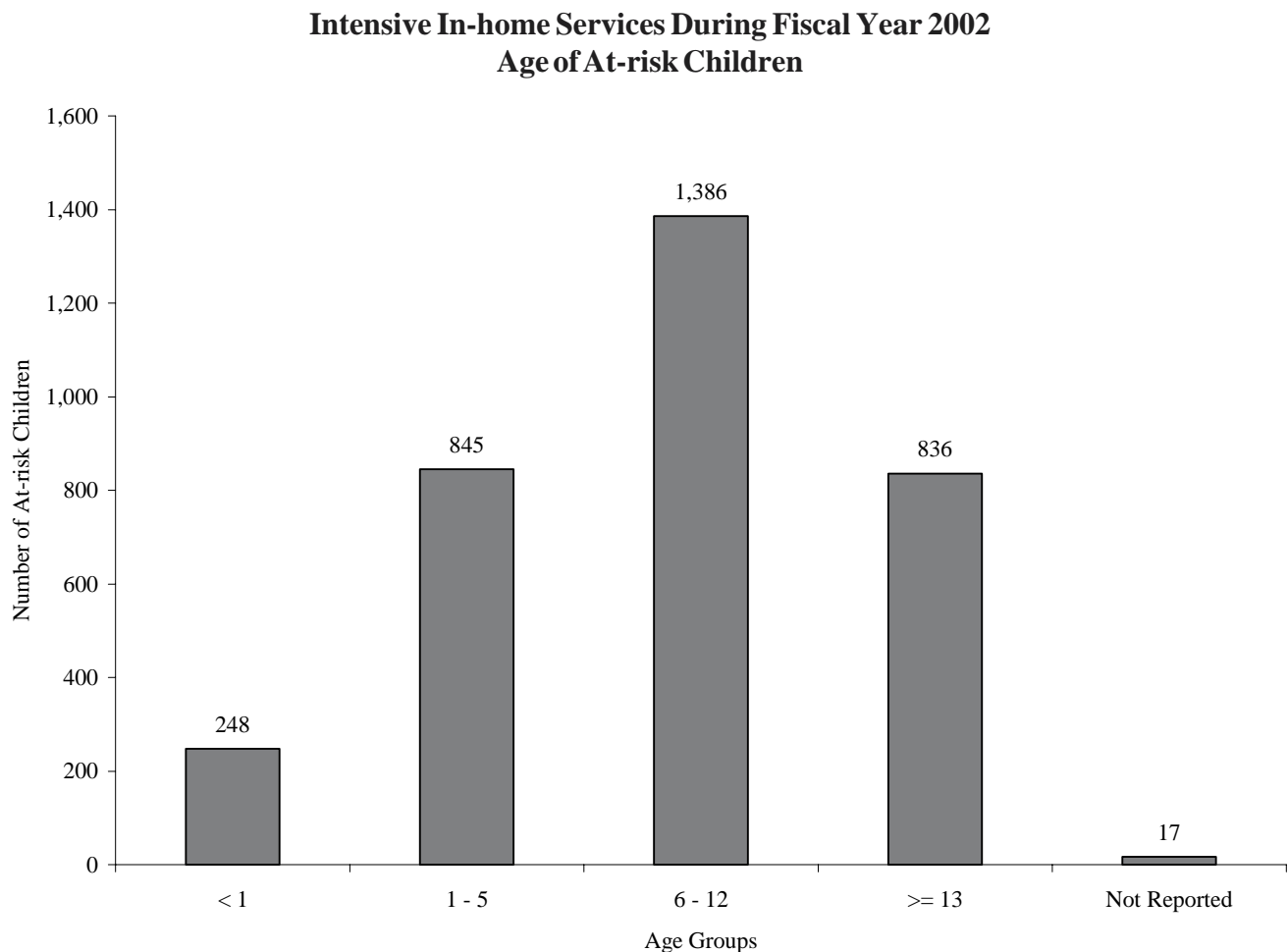

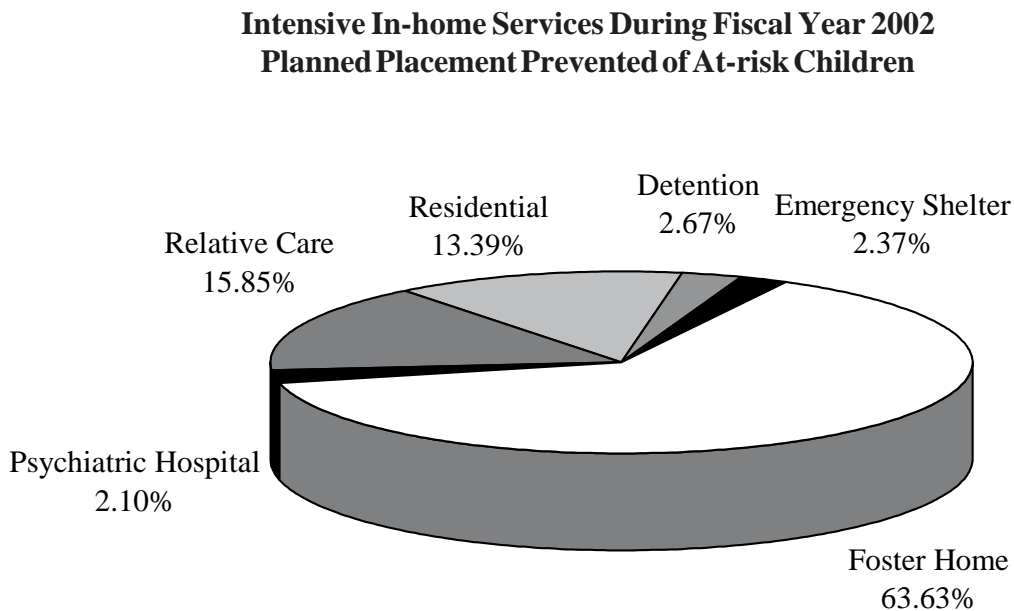
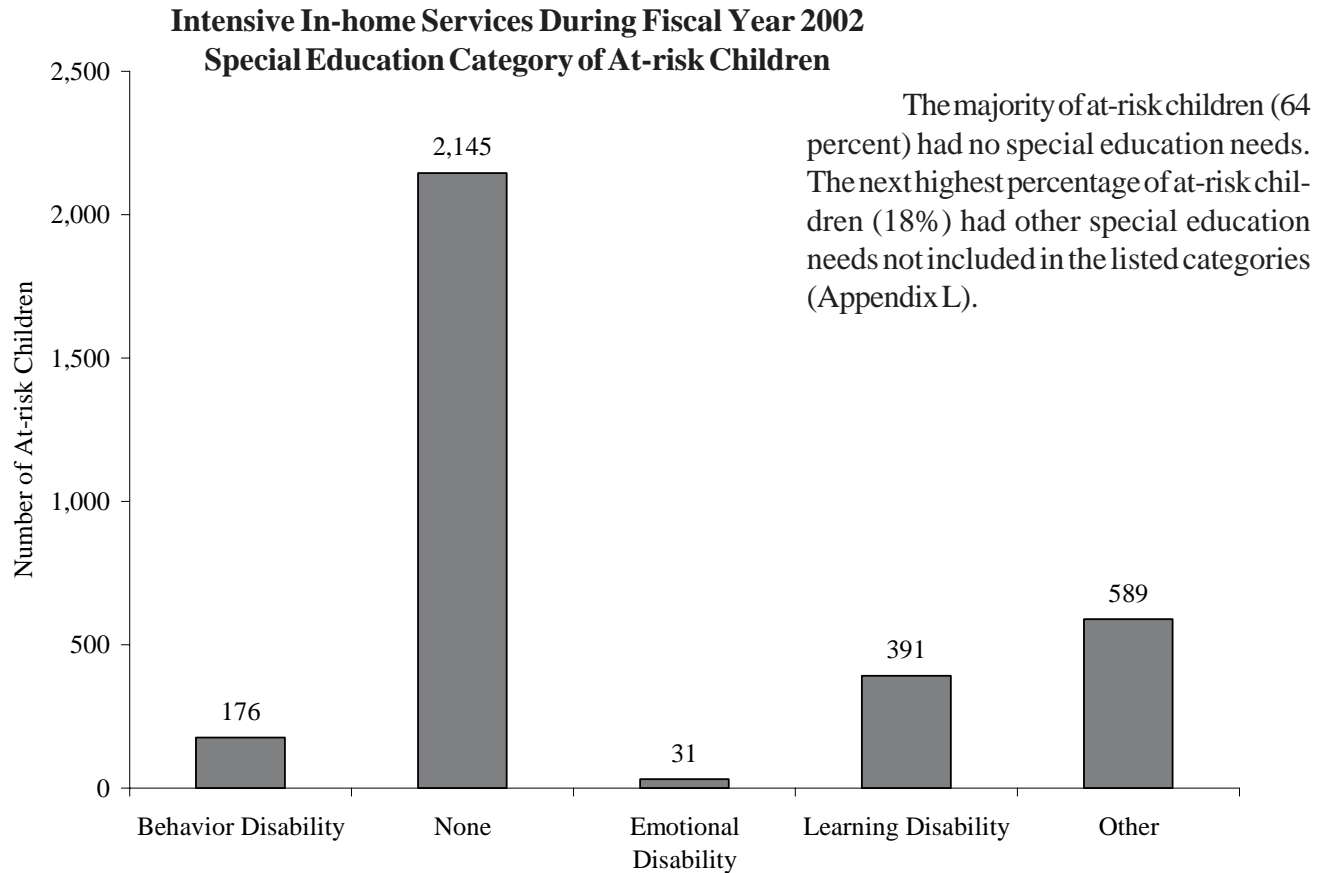
At-risk Children Characteristics of Families Accepted

Each IIS family has at least one child who is at risk of out-of-the-home placement. During FY 2002, at-risk children were slightly more likely to be male than female at 51% versus 49%. Sixty-two percent of at-risk children were white, 35% were black and the remaining 3% were other races or not reported (Appendix J and Appendix K). Most at-risk children (42%) were six to twelve years old (Appendix I).

At-risk Children Characteristics of Families Accepted (continued)



Sixty-four percent of the at-risk children avoided placement into foster homes by receiving IIS. Without IIS, 16 percent of the at-risk children would have been placed with relatives, another 13 percent in residential placements, three percent in detention, two percent in psychiatric hospitals and two percent in emergency shelters (Appendix M).

At-risk Children Characteristics of Families Accepted (continued)

Thirty-eight percent (1,277) of at-risk children had Parent/Child Conflict issues as the most common problem addressed in IIS during FY 2002. The next most common problems addressed were Parenting Skills Problems at 29 percent (954) and Communication at 26 percent (870).

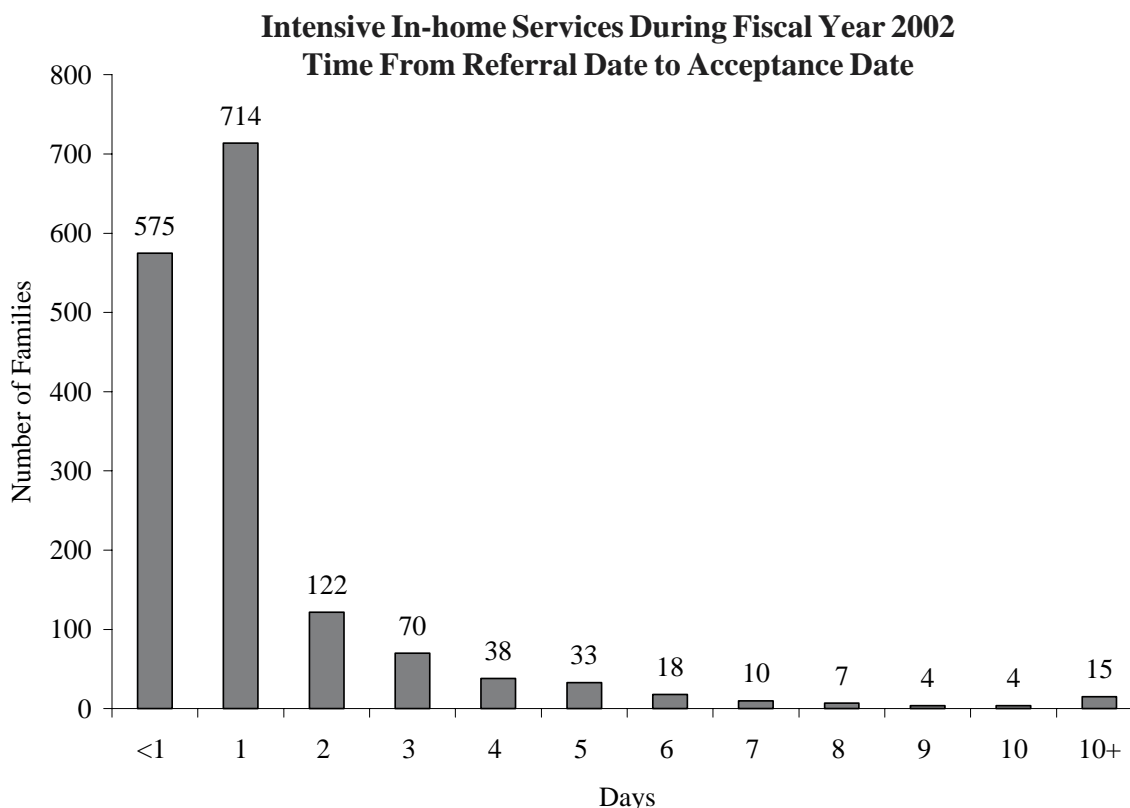
Prior Contacts

Of the 1,610 families accepted into IIS, 588 families had at least one contact with another agency prior to the IIS intervention. Those 588 families had a total of 1,488 prior contacts. Fifty-two percent of the prior contacts were with DFS, followed by 22% with the Juvenile Court.

Response Time

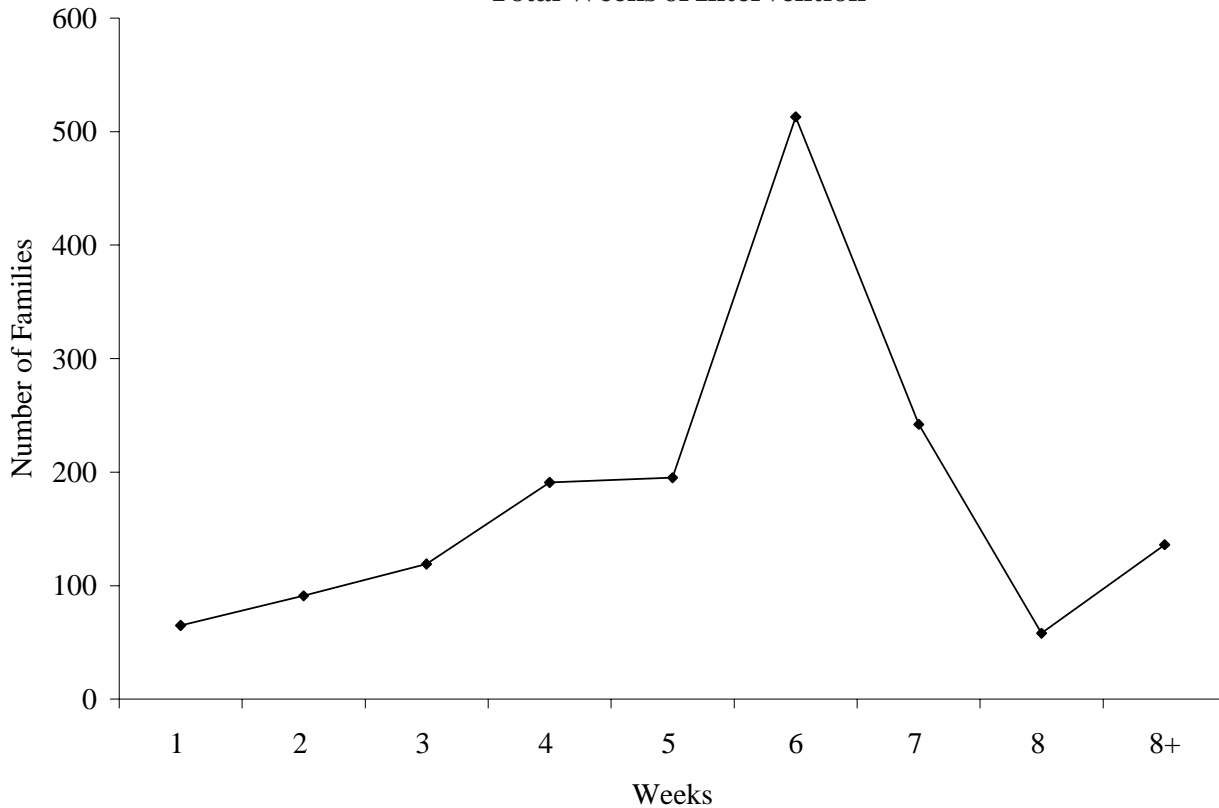
A family referred to IIS is first screened to determine the family's acceptance into the program. Once a family is accepted into IIS, an acceptance date is entered into the Intake Tracking System for that family and Intensive In-home Services begin. For the 1,610 families accepted into IIS, the average time between referral date to screen date was less than one day and the average time between screen date to acceptance date was one day. The total time between referral date to acceptance date averaged 1.28 days.



Total Weeks of Intervention

During FY 2002, the majority of families (72 percent) exited IIS within six weeks of acceptance into the program. The average length of intervention was 6.37 weeks.

Families and At-risk Children Exiting

Families and children who leave IIS during the fiscal year are considered to exit in one of the following categories: family intact, family not intact and other. Families are not intact if one of the following occurs: Child Ran Away, Child Moved Out of Home (not placed), Child Living with Relative or Guardian (not Court Ordered), Child Living with Relative or Guardian (Court Ordered), In Foster Home or Group Home, In Residential Treatment, With Division of Youth Services (DYS), In Juvenile Justice and In In-Patient Psychiatric Diversion. Other includes the following: Can't Locate Family, Information Not Available and Other. During FY 2002, 85 percent (1,303) of the 1,532 families and 88 percent (2,701) of at-risk children exiting IIS were reported to be in intact families (Appendix N).

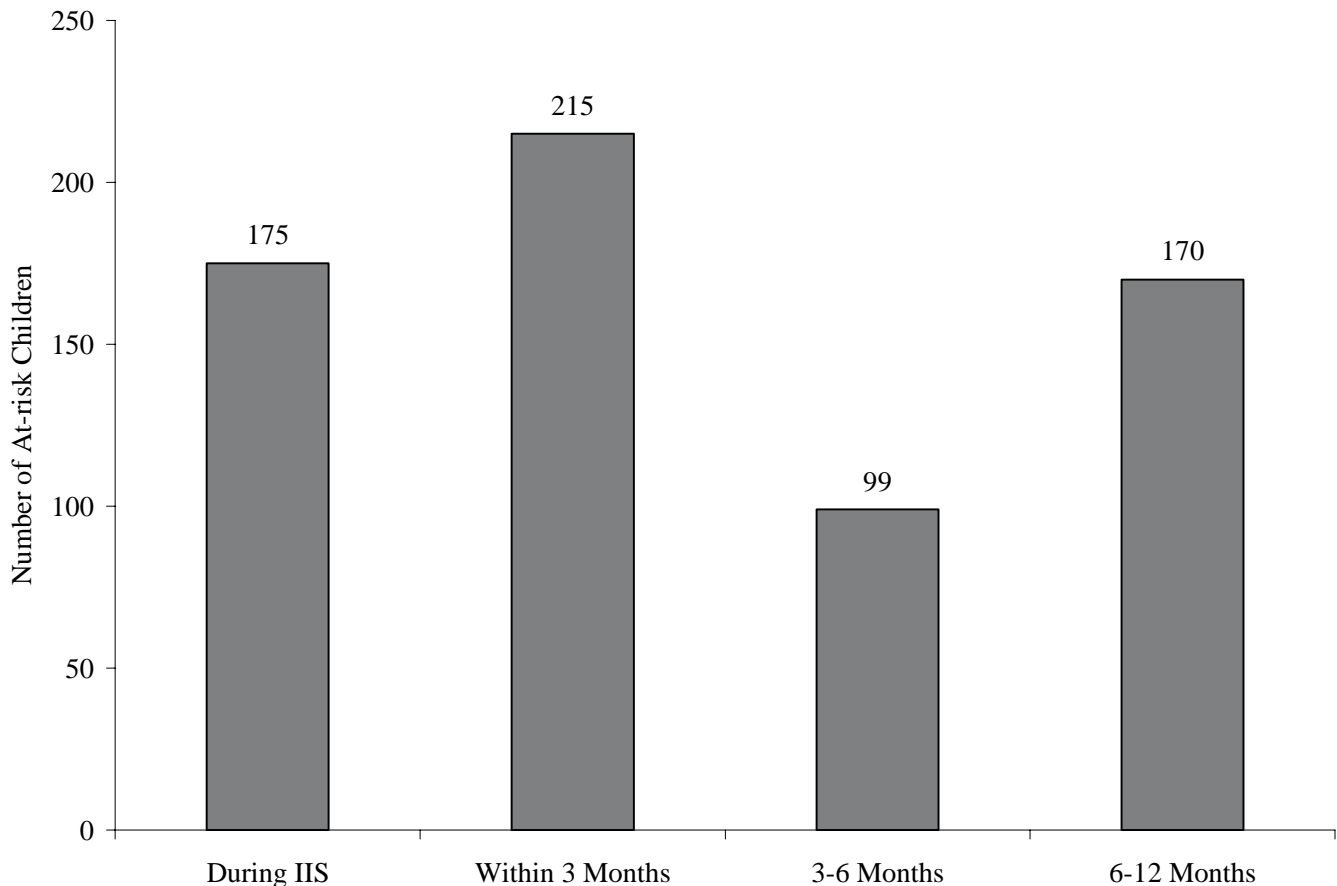
Outcomes

An at-risk child entering DFS or DYS alternative care during or after the IIS intervention affects the primary goal of keeping the family safely together. Family safety is also impacted if the child is a victim of a substantiated child abuse/neglect hotline during or after IIS intervention.

Children who exited IIS during FY 2001 were checked to see if they had entered DFS or DYS custody or if they were a victim of a substantiated child abuse/neglect hotline during IIS intervention or within 12 months of exiting IIS. FY 2001 exits were used to give all the children exiting enough time to see if the events had occurred.

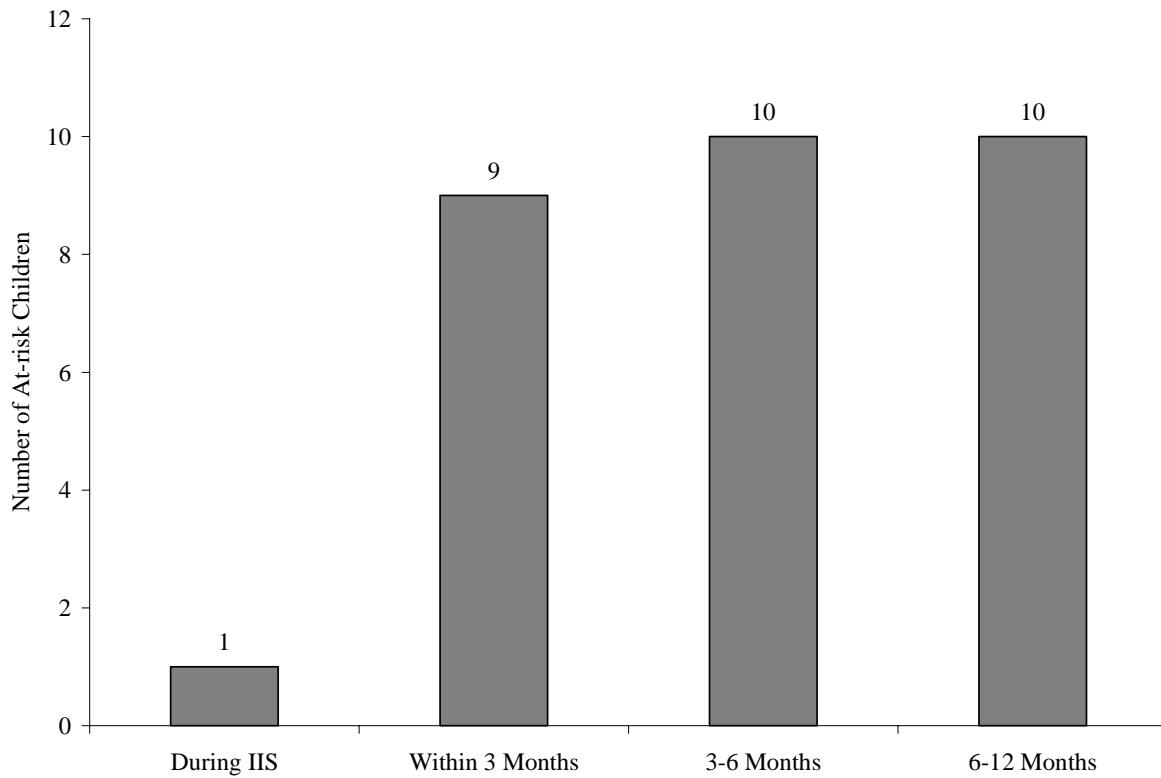
During FY 2001, 3,228 at-risk children exited IIS. Tracking those children during the IIS intervention and for the 12 months following the exit of their IIS intervention, 20% (659) entered DFS custody and one percent (30) entered DYS custody. Thirty-nine percent (1,265) of the children were victims of substantiated child abuse/neglect.

At-risk Children Who Entered DFS Alternative Care**

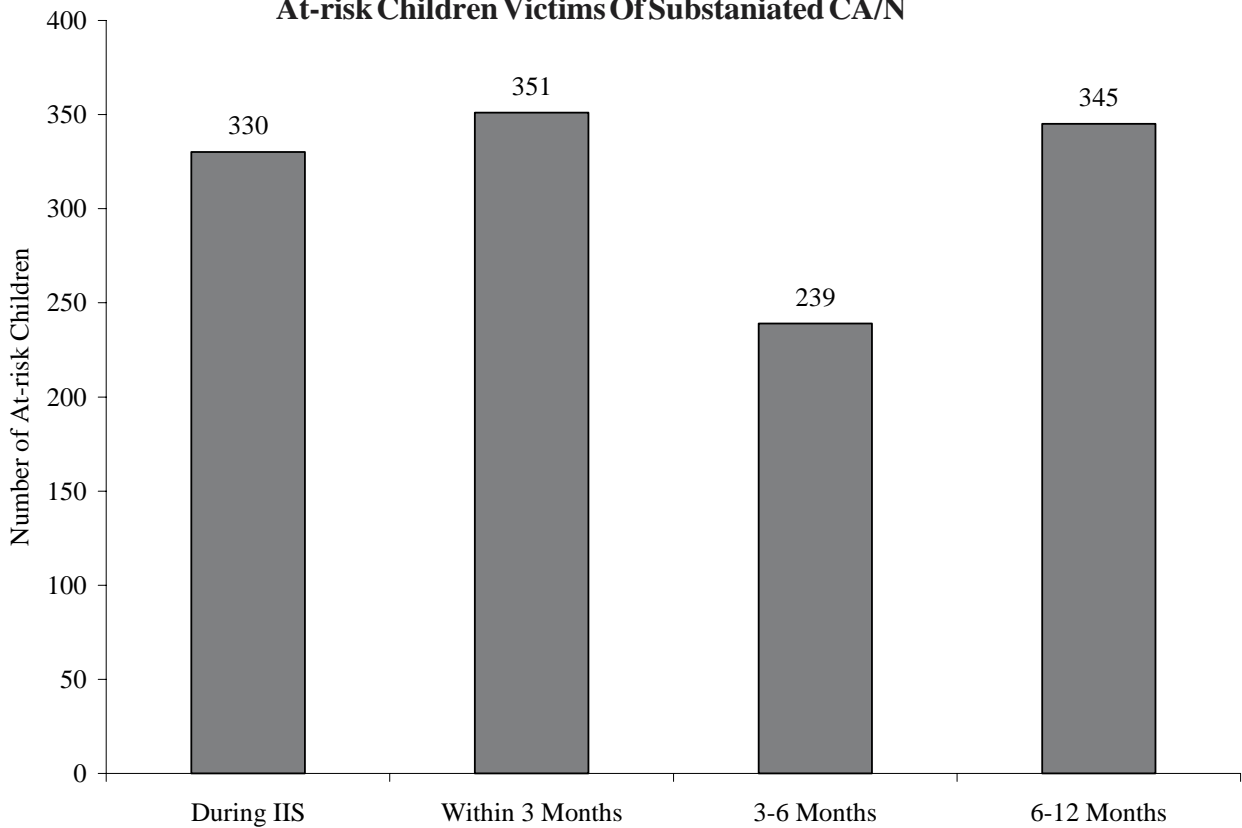
