<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>After School Youth Program Club</u> – Provides school aged member’s membership for one of the following programs per child per year: Girl Scouts; Boy Scouts; YMCA; LINC; 4-H; Girls on the Run; Boys and Girls Clubs. • <u>Baby Showers for Moms Program</u> – Expectant or new moms participate in fun activities, receive educational information regarding prenatal diet tips, baby care instructions, breast feeding instructions, and baby carrying demonstrations. • <u>Mobile Texting and ConnectionsPlus Phone Program</u> - High risk members within the Managed Care program will receive a password protected cell phone to connect with Home State Health Coaches, a 24/7 nurse advice hotline, and member’s primary care physician. Members will receive texts and personalized wellness goals. • <u>Video Conferencing Program</u> – Members who are enrolled in Health Coaching, Disease Management or Care Management Programs and have a phone or tablet compatible for video conferencing will be provided with face-to-face care management or disease management with a health coach. • <u>Waves Program</u> – Members who are enrolled in Care Management or Disease Management may be eligible for additional peak flow meters, spacers, hypoallergenic mattress covers and pillowcases, and a Self-Management Guide and Pediatric Guidebook. 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Enhanced and Same Day Transportation Program</u> (for members eligible for non-emergency transportation services as a covered benefit) – Including transportation to: all WIC appointments, hospital visits, Lamaze or similar birthing classes, pick-up prescriptions immediately following an appointment and multiple stops allowing the parent transportation from home to pick up children at school and then to doctor appointments. • <u>Weight Watchers Program</u> – Members ages 18 years or older, enrolled in diabetes Disease Management, BMI equal or greater than 30 will receive 13 local meeting vouchers and 14 weeks of online tools. • <u>Pacify</u> – Members who are pregnant or new mothers will receive 3-month subscription to Pacify app that helps connect mothers to lactation support consultants. • <u>Mom’s Meals</u> – Members who have delivered a baby within the past two (2) weeks and discharged from the hospital or meet other requirements may receive thirty (30) meals within thirty (30) days delivered to their home. • <u>Maternity Support Belt Program</u> – Members who are expecting and enrolled in the OB Care Management Program shall receive a maternity support belt. • <u>Breast Pump Program</u> – All enrolled expecting mothers will receive an electric breast pump within thirty (30) days of delivering.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>After School Program Clubs</u> – School –aged members receive membership to one of the following clubs per child per year: 4-H, Boys and Girls Club, Girl Scouts, and Boy Scouts. • <u>Art Therapy</u> – Limited to members ages 3 and older with certain diagnoses and participate in a Care or Disease Management Program • <u>Caregiver Influenza Vaccine</u> – Caregiver of active member of Missouri Care with no insurance will receive a CVS card to take to any CVS pharmacy to receive vaccine. • <u>Caregiver Pertussis Vaccine</u> – Caregiver of active member of Missouri Care with no insurance will receive a CVS card to take to any CVS pharmacy to receive vaccine. • <u>Cell Phone Program</u> – High-risk pregnancy members currently enrolled in a Prenatal Care Management Program, and meet other criteria, will receive a cell phone to connect to care manager, doctor, support group, etc. • <u>Peak Flow Meters</u> – unlimited peak flow meters to 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Equine Therapy</u> - Members ages 6 and older with active treatment plan with a diagnosis of Autism will receive 10 riding sessions per year at PATH Centers throughout Missouri. • <u>Maternity Support Hose and Support Belts</u> • <u>HiSet Program</u> – Members ages 16 or older who meet certain criteria will receive one (1) HiSet Exam voucher (which include all 5 tests) per year with completion of 40 hours of state-approved adult education classes and a ready test and/or Official Practice. • <u>Hypoallergenic Bedding Program</u> – Members diagnosed with Asthma (trigger of dust mites), completion of an Asthma Action Plan and meet other criteria will receive hypoallergenic mattress and pillowcases to accommodate bed size. • <u>Maternity Program</u> – Pregnant members will have access to an OB nurse 24 hours a day, 7 days a week to provide support, weekly assessments, education, and high risk pregnancy monitoring. Eligible members receiving 17P can have medication administered in their home. • <u>Concierge Program</u> – A triage (call center) of advocacy specialist who help members with social barriers navigate through the health care system with medical and non-medical needs. • <u>Childbirth and Breastfeeding Classes</u>

<p>asthmatic members without prior authorizations and can be mailed directly to their home.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Diabetes Camp</u> – ages 8 to 17 years old, insulin dependent diabetes, medically indicated by an Endocrinologist. Education and guidance on the basics of diabetes management, nutrition and exercise instructions. • <u>Diabetic Foot Care</u> – includes routine trimming of nails, corns and calluses for members with diabetes. • <u>Curve Complete Program</u> – three-month membership for children 12-17 years of age, BMI ranked in 85% percentile; for adults 18 years or older, BMI equal or greater than 25. • <u>Visual Impairment Camp</u> – ages 8 to 14, one-week camp provides an opportunity to experience social and recreational activities, and learn fundamental skills that help children learn, play and grow. • <u>Electric Breast Pump Program</u> – Members who are new mothers will receive electric breast pumps with a prior authorization. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Enhanced Transportation Services</u> – (for members eligible for non-emergency transportation services as a covered benefit) including transportation to: all WIC appointments, parents visiting hospitalized children, breastfeeding, Lamaze or similar birthing classes, pick-up prescriptions immediately following an appointment, methadone clinic or administration of other medications at the methadone clinic, and behavioral health inpatient or residential facility for parents to participate in family therapy. • <u>Meals Program</u> – Members who have delivered baby within past 2 weeks, discharged from inpatient hospital and participates in Care Management may receive 10 healthy balanced meals delivered to members home. • <u>Weight Watchers Program</u> – six-month membership for children 13-17 years of age, BMI ranked in 85% percentile; for adults 18 years or older, BMI equal or greater than 25.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Airwaze Program</u> – Eligible members ages 5-18 with moderate to severe persistent asthma will receive one (1) year subscription for a Smart Inhaler Sensor provided by Propeller with downloadable Apple/Android app for asthma management and medication reminders. • <u>Enhanced Transportation Program</u> (for members not eligible for non-emergency transportation services as a covered benefit) – transportation to and from a medical appointment. • <u>Hypoallergenic Assistance Program</u> – All members with Asthma participating in care management will receive hypoallergenic mattress cover and pillowcase limited to \$150.00 annually per year. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>JOIN for ME Program</u> – one (1) year membership to kids and teens ages 6-17 and BMI ranked in the 85th percentile. Program includes sixteen (16) weekly sessions followed by an optional eight (8) monthly sessions. Program will take place at community centers. • <u>On My Way Program</u> – Website designed for members ages 14-26 who are transitioning out of foster care and/or leaving home for the first time. • <u>Peer Support Specialist Program</u> – MO HealthNet Managed Care members will receive face-to-face and/or telephonic support from Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Recovery Coaches and/or Foster Care Peer Support Specialist for behavioral health care management services provided by Optum. • <u>Electric Breast Pump Program</u> – All pregnant members will be eligible to receive one (1) electric breast pump within thirty (30) days of their estimated due date, and up to six (6) weeks after delivery.
