<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Enhanced Transportation Program</u> – All members, including those not eligible for non-emergency transportation, have access to transportation to and from a medical appointment, rides to the pharmacy, WIC appointments, Vocational Rehabilitation/Job Day Training, weight control programs, food pantry, and grocery stores. Pregnant members are also eligible for transportation to drug rehabilitation. • <u>Hypoallergenic Assistance Program</u> – All members with Asthma participating in care management will receive hypoallergenic mattress cover and pillowcase limited to \$150.00 annually per year. • <u>Electric Breast Pump Program</u> – All pregnant members will be eligible to receive one (1) electric breast pump within thirty (30) days of their estimated due date, and up to six (6) weeks after delivery. • <u>Sanvello App</u> – Members 13 and older may receive premium access to this evidence-based mobile app to find strategies, tools, and resources to help with stress, anxiety, and other common mental health struggles. Members do not need a clinical diagnosis and do not need to be experiencing symptoms of these conditions to use this app. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>One Pass</u> – Members 18 and older get a membership for access to both online and in-person gym options. Eligible One Pass gyms include YMCA, Planet Fitness, and Anytime Fitness. Members can search online at One Pass for gyms in their area • <u>Peer Support Specialist Program</u> – MO HealthNet Managed Care members will receive face-to-face and/or telephonic support from Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Recovery Coaches and/or Foster Care Peer Support Specialist for behavioral health care management services provided by Optum. • <u>Youth Membership Program</u> – School-aged members receive membership to Boys and Girls Club of Greater St. Louis (BGC) per child per year: 5 club locations throughout St. Louis County and St. Louis City. • <u>YMCA Membership</u> – Members 17 and younger can obtain a YMCA membership and will have access to the sports, activities, and gym equipment available at their facility of choice. Members' access to services will depend on their age and YMCA guidelines. • <u>Mom's Meals</u> – Members who have delivered baby may receive 30 healthy balanced meals, 2 per day, delivered to member's home following discharge from the hospital.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>After School Youth Program Club</u> – Provides school aged member's membership for one of the following programs per child per year: Girl Scouts; Boy Scouts; YMCA; LINC; 4-H; Girls on the Run; Boys and Girls Clubs. • <u>Baby Showers for Moms Program</u> – Expectant or new moms participate in fun activities, receive baby supplies and educational information regarding prenatal diet tips, baby care instructions, breast feeding instructions, and baby carrying demonstrations. • <u>Mobile Texting and ConnectionsPlus Phone Program</u> – High risk members within the Managed Care program will receive a password protected cell phone to connect with Home State Health Coaches, a 24/7 nurse advice hotline, and member's primary care physician. Members will receive texts and personalized wellness goals. • <u>Waves Program</u> – Members who are enrolled in Care Management or Disease Management may be eligible for additional peak flow meters, spacers, hypoallergenic mattress covers and pillowcases, and a Self-Management Guide and Pediatric Guidebook. • <u>Breast Pump Program</u> – All enrolled expecting mothers will receive an electric breast pump within thirty (30) days of delivering. • <u>Pacify</u> – Members who are pregnant or new mothers will receive 3-month subscription to Pacify app that helps connect mothers to lactation support consultants. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Enhanced and Same Day Transportation Program</u> (for members eligible for non-emergency transportation services as a covered benefit) – Including transportation to: all WIC appointments, hospital visits, Lamaze or similar birthing classes, pick-up prescriptions immediately following an appointment and multiple stops allowing the parent transportation from home to pick up children at school and then to doctor appointments. • <u>Weight Watchers Program</u> – Members ages 18 years or older, enrolled in diabetes Disease Management, BMI equal or greater than 25 will receive 13 local meeting vouchers and 14 weeks of online tools. • <u>Mom's Meals</u> – Members who have delivered a baby within the past two (2) weeks and discharged from the hospital or meet other requirements may receive thirty (30) meals within thirty (30) days delivered to their home. • <u>Maternity Support Belt Program</u> – Members who are expecting and enrolled in the OB Care Management Program shall receive a maternity support belt. • <u>Automatic Blood Pressure (BP) Cuff Program</u> – Members ages 21 and older who are identified by a Care Manager to have risk factors that increase blood pressure will receive an automatic blood pressure cuff for at home monitoring.

- After School Program Clubs – School-aged members receive membership to one of the following clubs per child per year: 4-H, Boys and Girls Club, Girl Scouts, and Boy Scouts.
- Cell Phone Program – Members who qualify for the Federal Lifeline Program will receive 200 bonus minutes upon enrollment (once per lifetime) and 200 bonus minutes during their birthday month as long as they remain a Healthy Blue member.
- Electric Breast Pump Program – Members who are new mothers will receive electric breast pumps with a prior authorization.
- Equine Therapy – Members ages 6 and older with active treatment plan with a diagnosis of Autism will receive 10 riding sessions per year at PATH Centers throughout Missouri.
- Gym Membership – Members 18 and older with a diagnosis of obesity will receive one (1) voucher for enrollment fees and 3 months of dues to participating gym of their choice.
- Baby Showers – Pregnant and new mothers will receive baby supplies and education on topics including, but not limited to, pre/post-delivery care, healthy eating tips, family planning, and information about Additional Benefits and available resources.
- Asthma Spacer – Members age 10 and under with diagnosis of asthma will receive two (2) asthma spacers.
- Childbirth and Breastfeeding Classes
- HiSet Program – Members ages 16 or older will receive one (1) HiSet Exam voucher (which include all 5 tests) per year.
- Art Therapy – Limited to members ages 3 and older with certain diagnoses and participate in a Care or Disease Management Program.
- Industry Certification – Adult Expansion members age 18 to 64 can complete an industry certification in fields such as Real Estate, Information Technology, Health Services, etc. This is a once per lifetime benefit.
- Uniform and Work Attire – Adult Expansion members age 18 to 64 can receive one (1) gift card to purchase uniforms or work attire upon completion of their Industry Certification.
- Personal Care Items – Adult Expansion members age 18 to 64 can receive one (1) Amazon gift card per year to purchase personal hygiene products.
- Transportation Essentials – Adult Expansion members age 18 to 64 will be able to select one (1) transportation option per year which will meet their needs: Uber gift card, 30 day bus pass, if the member has their own car, they
- Maternity Support Hose and Support Belts
- Hypoallergenic Bedding Program – Members diagnosed with Asthma will receive \$100 credit per year to purchase a hypoallergenic mattress cover, fitted sheets, and pillowcases to accommodate bed size.
- Concierge/Welcome Room Program – A triage (call center) and three in-person meeting locations (St. Joseph, Columbia, and Cape Girardeau) of advocacy specialists who help members with social barriers navigate through the health care system with medical and non-medical needs.
- Enhanced Transportation Services – (for members eligible for non-emergency transportation services as a covered benefit) including transportation to: all WIC appointments, parents visiting hospitalized children, breastfeeding, Lamaze or similar birthing classes, pick-up prescriptions immediately following an appointment, methadone clinic or administration of other medications at the methadone clinic, and behavioral health inpatient or residential facility for parents to participate in family therapy.
- Meals Program – Members who have delivered baby within past 2 weeks, discharged from inpatient hospital and participates in Care Management may receive 14 healthy balanced meals delivered to member's home.
- Chronic Illness Management – Members with a diagnosis of Hypertension, Diabetes, CHF, CAD, obesity, and pregnant women with pre-eclampsia will receive a digital scale and a blood pressure cuff to help them monitor their condition.
- New Moms Benefit – Members who are pregnant and in the third trimester or within 60 days post-delivery will have their choice of one of the five items delivered to them to help prepare and care for their new baby. The five items include a car seat, safe sleep kit, diapers, breastfeeding kit, and a portable crib.
- SDOH Program – Active members are eligible to receive face-to-face Care Transition visits with a Community Health Worker, which may include, but not limited to, understanding post discharge, closing gaps in care and social barriers, connections to community resources, and connections to their primary care provider.
- ULearn – Adult Expansion and foster care members age 17 to 64 will receive access to the ULearn online platform for skills assessments, 1-on-1 coaching for next steps (GED, trade school, certifications, etc.) and exam preparations for various certifications.
- Household Essentials – Adult Expansion and foster care members age 17 to 64 will receive a one (1) Goodwill gift card to purchase household essentials.
- Personal Care Items – Adult Expansion members age 18 to 64 can receive one (1) Amazon gift card per year to purchase

can receive a gas card or a gift card for an oil change.

- Cell Data and Phone Benefit: - Members who have been identified as a High Risk-Pregnancy, Chronic Illness, High Emergency Room utilizer, and/or a Behavioral Health member in need of follow-up after hospitalization support, will receive up to 12 months of access to a cell phone, if they do not have a phone through the federal subsidy program.
