<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Cell Phone Program</u>: Members who qualify for the Federal Lifeline Program will receive 200 bonus minutes upon enrollment (once per lifetime) and 200 bonus minutes during their birthday month as long as they remain a Healthy Blue member. • <u>Equine Therapy</u>: Members age 6 and older with an active treatment plan and a diagnosis of Autism will receive 10 riding sessions per year at PATH Centers throughout Missouri. • <u>Baby Showers</u>: Pregnant and new mothers will receive baby supplies and education on topics including, but not limited to, pre/post-delivery care, healthy eating tips, family planning, and information about Additional Benefits and available resources. • <u>Asthma Spacers</u>: Members age 10 and under with diagnosis of asthma will receive two (2) asthma spacers. • <u>Childbirth and Breastfeeding Classes</u>: Pregnant mothers can receive membership for child birthing classes, breastfeeding classes, or both at their local hospital. • <u>HiSet Program</u>: Members ages 16 or older will receive one (1) HiSet Exam voucher (which include all 5 tests) per year. • <u>Art Therapy</u>: Members 3 and older with autism, a diagnosis of cancer or cancer recurrence, PTSD or emotional abuse within the past two years, who participate in case/disease management and have completed a comprehensive assessment will have the cost of Art therapy covered. • <u>Industry Certification</u>: Adult Expansion members age 19 to 64 can complete an industry certification in fields such as 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Concierge/Welcome Room Program</u>: A triage (call center) and three in-person meeting locations (St. Joseph, Columbia, and Cape Girardeau) of advocacy specialists that helps members with social barriers navigate through the health care system with medical and non-medical needs. • <u>Enhanced Transportation Services</u>: (Members eligible for non- emergency transportation services as a covered benefit will receive transportation to the following): All WIC appointments; Parents visiting hospitalized children; Breastfeeding, Lamaze or similar birthing classes; Picking up prescriptions immediately following an appointment; Methadone clinic or administration of other medications at the methadone clinic; Behavioral health inpatient or residential facility for parents to participate in family therapy; HCY Appointments. • <u>Meals Program</u>: Members who delivered a baby within past 2 weeks, were discharged from an inpatient hospital and participate in Care Management may receive 14 healthy balanced meals delivered to their home. • <u>SDOH Program</u>: Active members are eligible to receive face- to-face Care Transition visits with a Community Health Worker. This includes but is not limited to, understanding post discharge, closing gaps in care and social barriers, connections to community resources, and connections to their primary care provider. 	

Real Estate, Information Technology, and Health Services. This is a once per lifetime benefit.

- Uniform and Work Attire: Adult Expansion members age 18 to 64 can receive a \$150 gift card to purchase uniforms or work attire upon completion of their Industry Certification.
- Personal Care Items: Adult Expansion members age 19 to 64 can receive one \$25 gift card per year to purchase personal hygiene products.
- Transportation Essentials: Members 18 and older with an E2 eligibility designation (Adult Expansion) can select the options that best fit their needs: \$100 Uber Gift Card; \$100 gas card; \$35 card for an oil change; 30 day buss pass; and \$150 for car repairs if own a car.
- Get Better Connected (Cell Data and Phone Benefit): Members who have been identified as having a High Risk-Pregnancy, Chronic Illness, High Emergency Room utilizer, and/or a Behavioral Health member in need of follow-up after hospitalization support, will receive up to 12 months of access to a cell phone, if they do not already have a phone through the federal subsidy program.
- Healthy Adults Healthy Results: Members 18 to 64 with a diagnosis of obesity and/or diabetes will receive the following: Three-month gym membership and access to a fitness center; Weight Watchers (WW) voucher to cover initiation fees and thirteen weeks of membership; One produce box per month for three months.
- Asthma Relief Toolkit: Members diagnosed with Asthma will be able to select up to \$200 of asthma relief products from a catalog of options.
- Baby and Toddler Essentials: Members who are pregnant and due to deliver within 6 weeks or have delivered within

- ULearn: Adult Expansion age 19 to 64 will receive access to the ULearn online platform for skills assessments, 1-on-1 coaching for next steps (GED, trade school, and certifications), and exam preparations for various certifications.
- Household Essentials: Adult Expansion members ages 19 to 64 will receive a one (1) Goodwill gift card to purchase household essentials.
- Tutorial Services: Members age 12 to 17, who are failing in English, Mathematics, and/or Language Arts will received 24 tutoring hours.
- Healthy Kids Healthy Choices: Members between ages 5- 18 will receive \$30 to help cover the cost of a youth club membership. Members between 13-17 with a diagnosis of obesity and/or diabetes will be eligible for a Live Health Coach. Members between 6-18 with a diagnosis of obesity and/or diabetes will be eligible for the Farm Fresh Product.
- Nursing Support Program: Members who are pregnant will receive an electric breast pump and be able to choose one of the following: Breast-feeding support kit; Breast pump accessory kit; Microware sterilizer.
- Baby on the Way Bundle: Members who are pregnant will be able to select up to two of the following items to support a healthy pregnancy: Folic acid supplements; Maternity support hose; Maternity support belts; Compression socks; Maternity body pillow.
- Healthy Lifestyle Aids: Members with a diagnosis of Hypertension, Diabetes, CHF, CAD, obesity, and pregnant women with pre-eclampsia will receive up to a \$75 worth of lifestyle aids such as a digital scale, pulse oximeter, and abdominal binder.

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<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Enhanced Transportation Program</u>: All members, including those not eligible for non-emergency transportation, have access to transportation to and from a medical appointment, rides to the pharmacy, WIC appointments, Vocational Rehabilitation/Job Day Training, weight control programs, food pantry, and grocery stores. Pregnant members are also eligible for transportation to drug rehabilitation. • <u>Hypoallergenic Assistance Program</u>: All members with Asthma participating in care management will receive hypoallergenic mattress cover and pillowcase limited to \$150.00 annually per year. • <u>Peer Support Specialist Program</u>: MO HealthNet Managed Care members will receive face-to-face and/or telephonic support from Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Recovery Coaches and/or Foster Care Peer Support Specialist for behavioral health care management services provided by Optum. • <u>Sanvello App</u>: Members 13 and older may receive premium access to this evidence-based mobile app to find strategies, tools, and resources to help with stress, anxiety, and other common mental health struggles. Members do not need a clinical diagnosis and do not need to be experiencing symptoms of these conditions to use this app. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>One Pass</u>: Members 18 and older get a membership for access to both online and in-person gym options. Eligible One Pass gyms include YMCA, Planet Fitness, and Anytime Fitness. Members can search online at One Pass for gyms in their area. • <u>Electric Breast Pump Program</u>: All pregnant members will be eligible to receive one (1) electric breast pump per lifetime. Members can request one up to 60 days before their estimated due date, and up to six (6) weeks after delivery. • <u>YMCA Membership</u>: Members 17 and younger can obtain a YMCA membership and will have access to the sports, activities, and gym equipment available at their facility of choice. Members’ access to services will depend on their age and YMCA guidelines. • <u>Mom’s Meals</u>: Members who have delivered baby may receive 30 healthy balanced meals, 2 per day, delivered to member’s home following discharge from the hospital. • <u>Wellhop</u>: All pregnant members in their second trimester to about 4 months postpartum can enroll in the Wellhop Centering App Program. They are assigned a centering group with mothers in the same gestational period and to a group facilitator they can meet with individually.
