#### Notes from mtg:

- DISCUSSION ITEM: Definition of home visiting/home visitation programs
  - O Decision to reframe the criteria on the original survey of community programs from questions to statements and adding the following:
    - the term "voluntary"
    - the idea that HV is a method of delivery that focuses on one or more of the following outcomes:
      - school readiness
      - child and family health and well-being
    - that home visiting achieves outcomes through a focus on the child within the context of family
  - o The revised definition will be reviewed at our next meeting.
- DISCUSSION ITEM: Review of HV Matrix
  - o DECISION add attachment with all of the ACA approved HV models
  - o Revisit the question of "demonstrated outcomes."
    - Consider removing the "demonstrated outcomes" row from the matrix and add that level of detail as an addendum.
    - Next steps re the matrix: look at MIECHV benchmarks/indicators to see what benchmarks we would like to see in MO HV programs.
      - ADD TO AGENDA for next meeting schedule as in-person meeting.
      - Also bring benchmarks from other models (e.g., Healthy Families)
    - Consider in "Why does this program exist" row: set up as "check box" for agreed upon benchmarks.
- DISCUSSION ITEM: How does home visiting fit within MO's "comprehensive early childhood system?"
  - o Recommendation: take question to CBEC for input:
    - What is the role of HV to early learning programs?
    - What is the role of HV to comprehensive EC system?
  - o Workgroup comments:
    - HV is a core component of EC system
    - Serves the function (in part) of an early learning program
  - o Consider additional definitions in CBEC/ECCS Strategic Plan:
    - Early learning programs
    - Family Support
    - Parenting Education
    - Family Leadership
