### **Agency and Partner Updates**

- Stephanie—DHSS, Section for Child Care Regulation In the past few weeks they have had 146 people take the online Early Childhood Social & Emotional Health training that was developed by this workgroup.
- Beth Ann—Child Care Aware of Missouri has a new Director of Training—Jonni McCaslin. The national program, Taking Steps to Healthy Success ends in September, but Missouri is one of three states have been selected to continue for another year. DHSS funding will allow Child Care Aware to start a program, Taking Steps, in Joplin and Macon/Moberly area.
- Jo Anne—DESE is working on securing keynote speakers for next year's Conference on the Young Years.
- Julie—DMH/Project LAUNCH will co-sponsor a cohort of Parent Café Train-the-Trainer in the KC/Mid-Missouri area. The purpose is to develop 6-8 certified parent café trainers and will offer Parent Care Institute Training to two communities. They are also offering a conference for doctors focusing on children's social/emotional health on August 25<sup>th</sup>. The conference is being sponsored in partnership with the Missouri Chapter of the American Academy of Pediatrics and University of Missouri School of Medicine. Project LAUNCH fund end on September 30<sup>th</sup>, but they will be requesting a no-cost extension.

#### **Early Childhood Summit**
