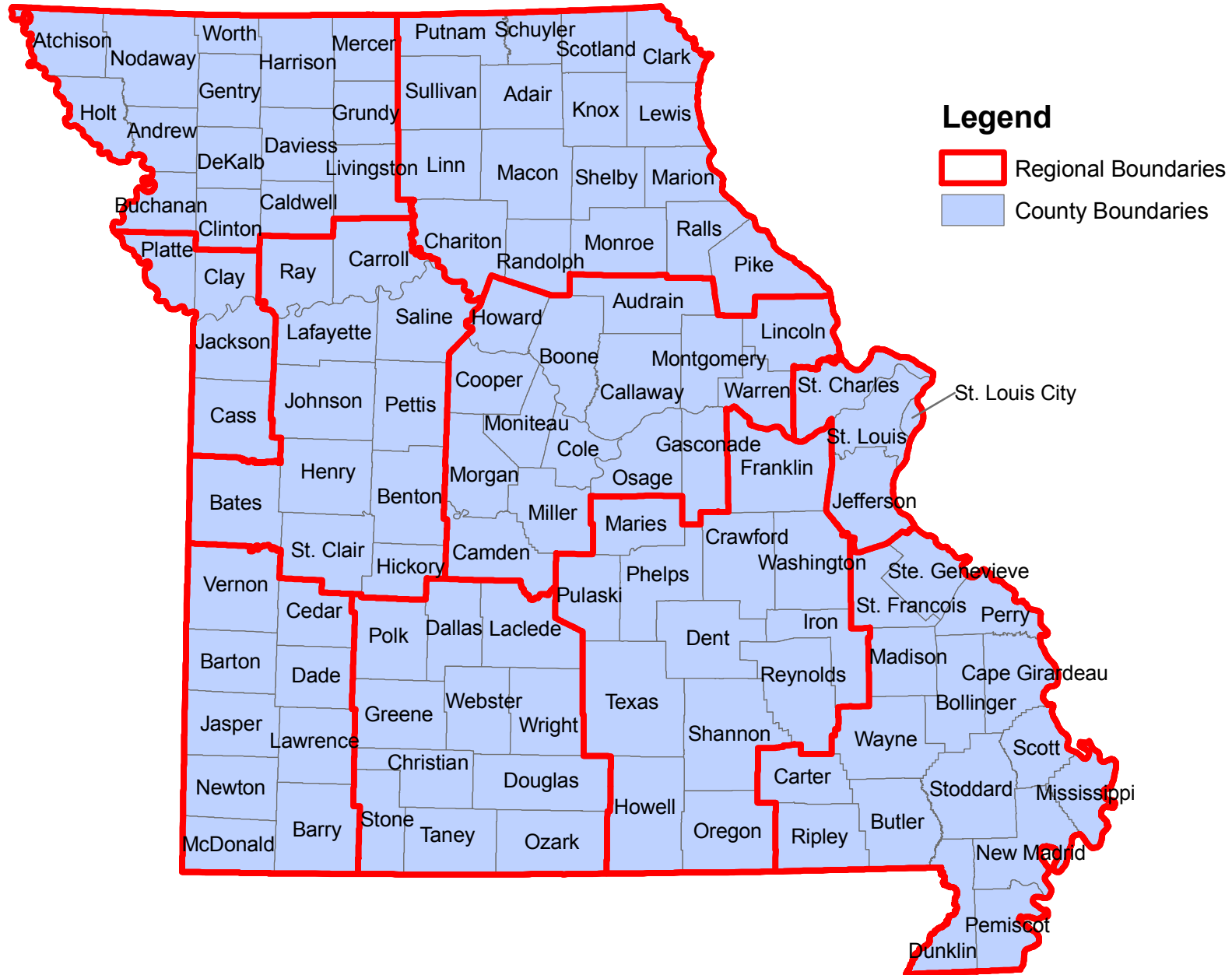


# Educational Regions
