#### What is it?

The Department of Social Services is introducing a new and improved way for child care providers to track their child attendance.

The new system, called the Child Care Business Information Solution, will:

- Allow you to track child attendance online
- Automatically calculate daily units of care for each child
- Give you 24/7 access to child care authorization records
- Let parents check their Child Care Subsidy eligibility information anytime through a Parent Portal
