The law allows CD to concurrently engage in reasonable efforts toward reunification while engaging in such other measures as are deemed appropriate for CD to establish a permanent placement for the child. §211.183

Diligent search for placement able to handle large sibling group or working with multiple placement providers to accommodate placement of a sibling group					
Visitation with siblings, relatives, parents (including incarcerated parents)					
TPR referral form and TPR completed					
Preparing the child for adoption					
Adoption recruitment – Heart Gallery, Adopt US Kids, Adoption Exchange					
Residential placement for child					
Paternity testing for man named as the father					
Obtained educational information regarding school attendance, IEP, vaccinations, birth certificate, medical records, health screenings					
Obtained information on family medical/mental health history					
Adoption subsidy paperwork completed					
Talked with relative about interest in pursuing guardianship or adoption					
Therapy provided for older youth who does not want parental rights terminated					
ICPC priority home study request made					
Referral to Chafee program					
Rule out all other permanency plans as not in child's best interest
