This form must be submitted to the Children's Division and will be filed in the child care provider registration file.

**SECTION B \* Required Fields Must Be Completed**

License-exempt school based child care program directors and staff/volunteers responsible for the supervision of children are required to complete training in all of the following topics by June 30, 2017. Training in the following topics may be met through professional development training provided by the school district or their designee or trainings offered outside of the Missouri Workshop Caelendar.

- First aid and cardiopulmonary resuscitation
- Prevention of Sudden Infant Death Syndrome and Safe Sleeping (Required for programs serving children less than 2 years old) \* **Does your center serve children less than 2 years old?** Yes  No  **If 'Yes', training must be completed for this topic.**
- Prevention of Shaken Baby Syndrome and Abusive Head Trauma (Required for programs serving children less than 2 years old) \* **Does your center serve children less than 2 years old?** Yes  No  **If 'Yes', training must be completed for this topic.**
- Emergency Disaster and Response
- Mandatory Child Abuse and Neglect (CA/N) Reporting
- Prevention and Control of Infectious Diseases, including Immunizations
- Administration of Medication, Consistent with Standards for Parental Consent
- Prevention and Response to Food Allergy Emergencies
- Building and Physical Premises Safety, including Identification of and Protection from Hazards that can Cause Bodily Injury
- Handling and Storage of Hazardous Materials and the Appropriate Disposal of Biocontaminants
- Transportation of Children (Required if staff/volunteers transport children) \***Do staff/volunteers at your center transport children (includes transportation by staff/volunteers to field trips)?**

**SECTION C \*Required Fields Must Be Completed**

If you and all staff/volunteers responsible for the supervision of children in your child care facility have completed trainings in **all** of the topics listed above, sign and submit this form to the Department of Social Services (DSS), Children's Division. Please note that only training taken since January 1, 2016 will be accepted with the exception of First Aid/CPR if the certification is current. The completion of this form is considered confirmation that your facility is in compliance with the health and safety training requirements. Attach a listing of all facility staff/volunteers including their MOPD ID. The DSS may monitor your facility's training records at any time to ensure compliance with training requirements.
