SUBJECT: REVISED AUTHORIZATION TO PROVIDE ALTERNATIVE CARE, CS-33, FORM

DISCUSSION:

The purpose of this memorandum is to inform staff of revisions made to the *Authorization to Provide Alternative Care (CS-33)* form and instructions to clarify the authorization is valid up to twenty-four (24) hours from the time that protective custody is taken, unless the child is released from protective custody, or a court order is signed by a judge/commissioner within the first twenty-four (24) hours. The revised language will appear in CS-33 forms produced at the Warehouse effective the date of this memorandum. There is no need to destroy CS-33 forms produced following the release of memorandum CD12-34.
