

Q: What is the plan for the Mobile CA/N units when testimony is required for [protective custody] (PC) hearings? What will happen when different counties and circuits have court scheduled at the same time and the Mobile CA/N worker is needed at both? How does CD plan to address the judicial differences between circuits?

Mobile CAN unit members must continue to attend PC hearings when assigned. They will be notified by court administration in advance and may testify in person or virtually. Whenever possible, hearings will be scheduled locally to minimize travel burdens and ensure coordination with local court staff.

In case of schedule overlaps, Mobile CAN staff must inform their supervisor and both affected courts immediately. The regional coordinator will assess priorities—considering factors such as case urgency and distance. If necessary, hearings can be rescheduled, or an alternate CAN worker assigned. This coordination should occur at least 24–48 hours prior to the hearings.

Q: My program line is FCS, we help cover On Call. I'm scheduled in July for several days. How does that work now? Is it being covered by someone else?

For now, on call will remain in the circuits. Once specialized teams are established and fully operational – expected September 1, 2026 – on call duties will shift from the circuit to the MO CA/N Response team.

Question for KC Rafferty: On the [Upstream Youth Mapping] Map, I know the trauma support was towards the bottom of the stats... Can you share the reasoning for the placement for that a little bit more? How does that impact the family centered services, and the other higher stats?

The list of priorities you saw with the map were based on the number of jurisdictions that chose that item to action plan. There were only three jurisdictions that chose Trauma-informed services as an action plan, but it was likely a priority in many more workshops.
