- 6 Month Extensions October 1, 2025 to March 31, 2026
 - Allocations will be based on funding received for GY 25 and State General Revenue 3.5% reduction to each contract.
 - Contract Extension will be sent in September after we get the Award letter from DOJ and the new terms and conditions.
 - o Budget and Budget narratives went out August 5th and 6th 2025 DUE back no later than 9.30.25
- Quarterly report for October 2024 to June 2025
 - A qtr. report will be sent to you TODAY. Due back no later than 9.19.25
 - We need to justify the general revenue funds
 - We will provide instructions for each question on the Q Report.
 - For Question 3, we are looking for a #, not a Yes or a No.
 - For A-D, we are looking for unduplicated # of individuals who received that service category.
