What is CRF?

- ▶ CRF = Coronavirus Relief Fund
 - ▶ The CARES Act established the Coronavirus Relief Fund
 - ▶ Missouri's allocation was around \$2.3M with guidelines on how it could be spent
 - ▶ Office of Administration managed the fund
 - ▶ Initial spending included PPE, hand sanitizer, cleaning supplies, etc for across the State

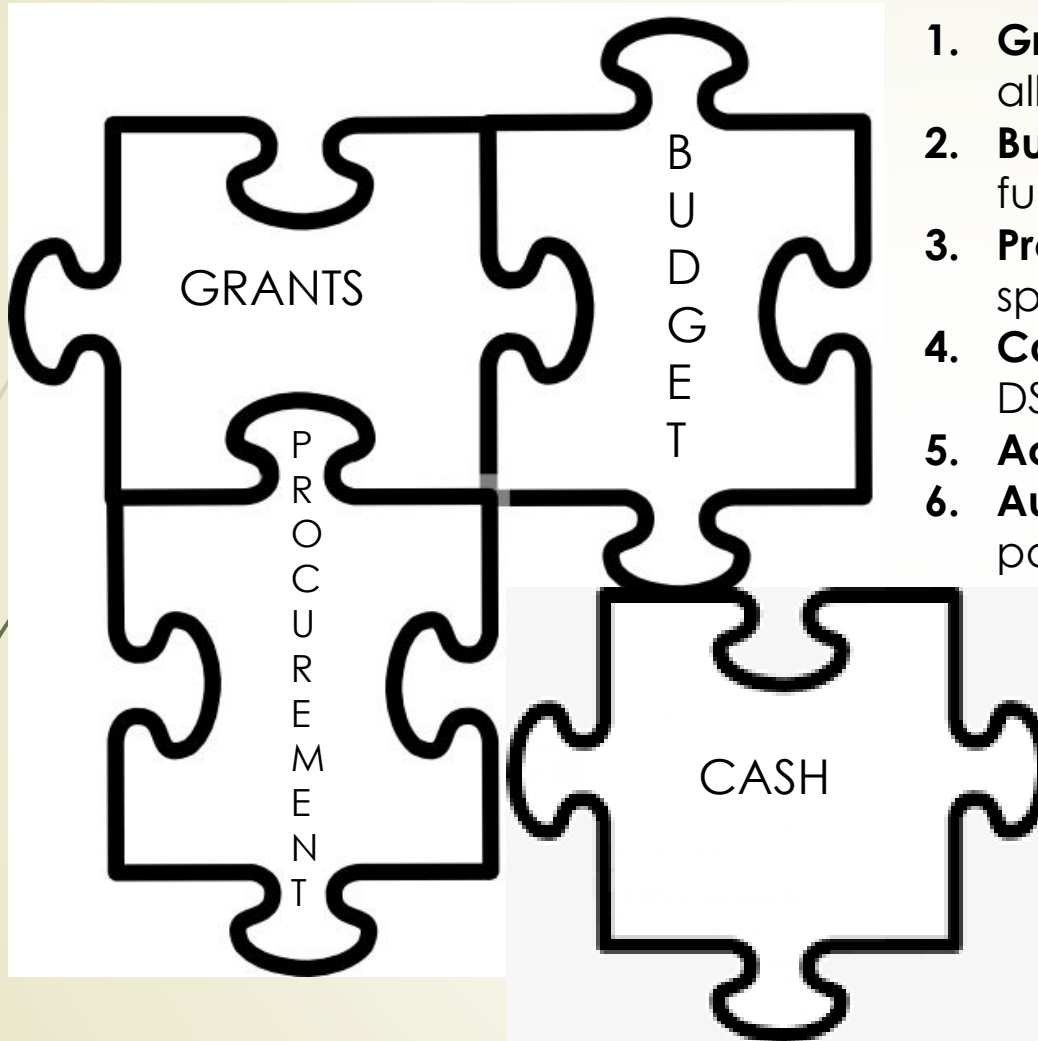

It takes a team to make this work



1. **Grants** gets the award letter informing Missouri on allocation and spending guidelines
2. **Budget** ensures proper appropriation authority to spend funds.
3. **Procurement** ensures proper contract mechanism to spend funds
4. **Cash** draws the funds from the federal banking system as DSS spends per guidelines
5. **Accounts Payable** processes the payments in SAMII
6. **Audit & Compliance** handles responses to Auditor's on payments
