
## History

- The Fairbanks started as a school in 1906. The doors closed in 2007.
- Quickly became a den for many undesirable actions and crimes, from prostitution, drugs, vandalism and more.
- That was until the Fairbanks was purchased by our CEO, Dr. Amy Blansit and her late husband, Drew Lewis.



## Legacy of Drew Lewis

- Drew and Amy started the Drew Lewis Foundation during his fight against cancer, determined to help those in need even during one of the hardest times of both of their lives.
- Sadly, Drew Lewis passed away a few months after they purchased the property.
- Determined to carry on their dream, Amy worked tirelessly to renovate and improve the Fairbanks to transform it into a community hub.



### **Drew Lewis Foundation**

- Our Mission: We educate, empower and support underserved families through personalized programs and coaching to increase quality of life and build resilient communities.
- We achieve this through several programs and approaches.
- Our main programs include the RISE program, the Nonprofit Career Academy, and the Blue House Project.



### Who We Serve

- Low- to moderate-income families and individuals who are stably homed, employed or looking for employment.

### **RISE: Reaching Independence through Support and Education**

- RISE is our series of classes that teaches members Finances, Banking, Advocacy, and Professional Development.
- Members improve food security, housing, employment, child care and so much more.
- A strong foundation is developed in the initial series of courses, which we call CORE.
- More advanced topics are taught in the follow up series of courses, which we refer to as Maintenance.
- Maintenance courses also include a number of expert guest speakers to complement our topics.





## **Blue House Project**

- We purchase blighted homes in Grant Beach, fully renovate them into not only livable, but welcoming homes.
- We then either sell or rent them to our RISE members and teach them all the skills necessary to become responsible homeowners.
- Families purchase the homes with built-in equity.
- BHP provides a unique and more accessible path to home ownership, as well as improve communities through the "broken window theory".

## Nonprofit Career Academy

- The Nonprofit Career Academy (NCA) is our newest initiative. It is a post-secondary education and training institution focused on the nonprofit sector.
- Delivers 96 hours of lessons over 16 weeks in order to confer certificates and basic education in the nonprofit sector.
