- THERAPEUTIC INJECTIONS

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Effective October 1, 2006 and after, Missouri Medicaid will no longer cover procedure code 90772 (Therapeutic, prophylactic or diagnostic injection, specify substance or drug; subcutaneous or intramuscular). This procedure code was inadvertently added with implementation of the 2006 Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) and Health Care Procedure Coding System (HCPCS). Missouri Medicaid policy states that this service is included in the office/outpatient visit or other procedure performed.
