Prior to March 1, 2007, School Districts may bill using their current therapy provider numbers (PT, 46, PT 47 or PT 48) as the billing provider or may bill using the School District's new clinic/group provider number (PT 50) as the billing provider and the individual therapist's provider number (if one has been received) as the performing provider.

Beginning March 1, 2007, services rendered by speech therapists, occupational therapists, and physical therapists in a school setting must be billed with the School District's clinic/group number as the billing provider and the individual therapist's provider number as the performing provider.
