



PHYSICIAN BULLETIN

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- **PROCEDURE CODES J0702 AND J7319**

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Effective November 1, 2007, procedure codes J0702 (Injection, Betamethasone Acetate and Betamethasone Sodium Phosphate, 3MG) and J7319 (Sodium Hyaluronate Injection) are no longer billable by physicians, except Rural Health Clinic (RHC) and Federally Qualified Health Clinic (FQHC) providers, on the CMS-1500 (08-05) form. To receive reimbursement for these injections physicians will need to bill the appropriate National Drug Code (NDC) on the pharmacy claim form, which can be found on the MO HealthNet Internet billing Web site, emomed.com. Billing procedures for RHC and FQHC providers have not changed.
