Welcome/Roll Call	Attendance as above	FYI
Approval of Minutes	Quorum is not present; the minutes from November 2018 meeting were not approved.	
Conduent Reports	Eric reviewed the reports with the committee members present. Dan was concerned with the low CyberAccess usage, which looked to be around 30%. Eric agreed. The usage has stagnated at where it is. Eric talked about Conduent outreaching to new providers and targeting providers in an effort to try to increase the usage. Dan wondered if there are any tools online or if the Helpdesk	FYI

	has any information for the providers. Geri stated they do tell providers about	
	CyberAccess and most already know about it. No other questions on reports.	
Mental Health	Eric informed the committee of the proposal for Mental Health Consultation	FYI
Consultation	services. There was interest in moving forward but was never implemented. It	
	has never been in front of this committee. Eric shared that Allyson was	
	concerned about limiting to psychologists. Vicky had the same concerns. It does	
	not make sense to limit providers. A majority of the providers who work with	
	children now are not psychologists. No SPA would be required with only	
	psychologists. With new SPA for LCSW & LPC for adult services, could be possible	
	now. We still need to figure out fiscal impact to see if feasible. Trying to present	
	this as budget neutral by reflecting a cost savings. Eric concerned with bundled	
	rate. Need to have bundled limits instead (daily and annual limits).	
BH Services in an IEP	Eric brought up the idea of excluding these services from requiring prior	FYI
	authorization as has been suggested by the MO School Boards Association. More	
	schools would be interested if they did not have to jump through hoops of the	
	prior authorization process. Vicky questioned why schools would not need PA if	
	other organizations do. Dan and Dawn did not have any comments.
