Executive Summary

Purpose: The MO HealthNet Pharmacy Program will implement a clinical edit.

Why was this Issue Selected: Some oral oncology agents are expensive and have serious side effects. The 15 day oral oncology program allows providers and participants to try these expensive medications that have serious side effects for a shorter amount of time so they can confirm effectiveness and tolerability prior to paying for a full 30-day supply, minimizing unnecessary expense, as well as medication waste. This program is for participants who are new starts only.

Setting & Population: All patients

Type of Criteria: **Increased risk of ADE** **Non-Preferred Agent**
 Appropriate Indications

Data Sources: **Only administrative databases** **Databases + Prescriber-supplied**

Setting & Population

- Drug/drug class for review: Oral Oncology Agents
- Age range: All patients

Approval Criteria

- Prescription claim with a calculated allowed amount of less than \$150.00, OR
- Prescription claim with calculated allowed amount greater than \$150 and a supply of less than or equal to 15 days OR
- Prescription claim for a product with the same HICL as a product in the patient's most recent 6 months of paid drug claim history.

- Absence of approval criteria
