## Executive Summary

**Purpose:** Ensure appropriate utilization and control of DisposeRx packets.

**Why Issue Selected:** MO HealthNet and the Missouri Board of Pharmacy continue to respond to the opioid crisis afflicting Missourians. MO HealthNet is pleased to announce the “Safe at Home” medication disposal initiative, in partnership with the Missouri Board of Pharmacy’s Rx Cares for Missouri Program and the Missouri Department of Health & Senior Services (DHSS).

DisposeRx® is an at-home oral medication disposal packet composed of FDA-approved materials and provides a simple, convenient, and effective solution for the disposal of unused or expired medication. These convenient at-home medication disposal packets allow MO HealthNet participants to dispose of unused opioids safely and easily, preventing accidental overdoses. Pharmacists in Missouri are able to dispense DisposeRx pursuant to the statewide Standing Order issued by the DHSS, available at <https://health.mo.gov/safety/bnnd/pdf/so-drug-deactivation-and-disposal-products.pdf> or pursuant to a prescription from an enrolled MO HealthNet provider with prescriptive authority. MO HealthNet will reimburse pharmacy providers who dispense DisposeRx to eligible MO HealthNet participants for up to 2 packets per participant every 45 days.
