

**Public Notice of Rate Methodology Change for the Department of Social Services, MO HealthNet Division
School-Based Individualized Education Plan (IEP) Direct Services**

Pursuant to Sections 1902(a)13(A) of the Social Security Act and 42 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 447.205, which mandate that proposed changes in statewide methods and standards for setting Medicaid payment rates be published and made available for review and comment, this is to advise that:

1. The Missouri Department of Social Services, MO HealthNet Division (DSS/MHD) provides notice of the following:

Effective for dates of service beginning July 1, 2018, Missouri public and charter schools will use a cost-based reimbursement process based on certified public expenditures including a process for quarterly reconciliation and final settlement to establish the actual cost for delivery of MO HealthNet covered school-based IEP direct services to MO HealthNet participants. This methodology change is contingent upon approval by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services.

2. The annual estimated cost of this methodology change to the DSS/MHD effective July 1, 2018 is \$0. The cost settlement for claims paid from July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019 will occur in fiscal year 2021. The estimated cost of the July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019 settlement is \$10 million. The payments for this methodology change will be funded with federal funds and state match coming from participating school districts. There will be no state funding impact to DSS.
3. The change in methodology will allow the DSS/MHD to claim additional federal funds to maximize revenue for Missouri public and charter schools that participate in the school-based IEP direct services program.
4. The change in methodology will also require changes to the School District Administrative Claiming (SDAC) program.
5.
