Dear Provider,

Alpha Maxx HealthCare, Inc. (AMAXX) is partnering with the Missouri Department of Social Services, MO HealthNet Division and Pemiscot County Hospital on a project known as the Missouri Perinatal Health Management Pilot Program.

The purpose of this pilot is to increase the number of healthy pregnancies of MO HealthNet participants. Expected outcomes include a decrease in prematurity, infant mortality, and the costs of NICU/PICU care, including re-hospitalizations, and in costs associated with the first year of life. The pilot program will provide care coordination and care management for high-risk obstetric patients for the duration of the pregnancy, and for newborn infants, up to one year of age, including NICU/PICU patients. An evidence-based initiative, this pilot is aligned with recommendations of the Missouri Task Force on Prematurity and Infant Mortality.


Alpha Maxx Healthcare, Inc. (AMAXX), the only population health management firm in the United States to be solely accredited with the National Committee for Quality Assurance's (NCQA's) "patient oriented high-risk pregnancy" designation from 2006 through 2015, operating in the Delta Regional Authority high impact area, will provide care coordination and management in an 8-county pilot region.
