

## Public Notice

Pursuant to the provisions of Title 42 Section 441.304(f), Code of Federal Regulations, public notice is given regarding the submission of the newly developed Structured Family Caregiving Waiver application. The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) requires states to obtain public input during the development of a waiver, a waiver renewal or a waiver amendment with substantive changes. Stakeholders are being asked to provide public input and comment in order to allow Missouri to submit this waiver application. The MO HealthNet Division (MHD) and the Department of Health and Senior Services (DHSS) Division of Senior and Disability Services (DSDS) have developed the Structured Family Caregiving Waiver to provide Home and Community-Based Services to MHD participants, 18 years of age and over, who have a diagnosis of Alzheimer's or a related disorder, that live and wish to continue living independently in their own homes or their family's home.
