1. **SLRHC Funding:** Under the previous MC+ Demonstration, what types of funding for the SLRHC did the State receive approval? Were the types of expenditures under the previous MC+ Demonstration the same as what the State is currently requesting? What would the \$300,000 under the proposed Demonstration be used for? Would the \$300,000 go toward salaries, benefits, and rent? If so, to whom would the State be paying rent?

Please feel free to use the chart below as a way of characterizing what the previous Demonstration funded and what the State proposes to fund under the proposed Demonstration.

Response: The previous MC+ Demonstration authorized that "a yearly amount of \$200,000 of this 6.27% of disproportionate share hospital (DSH) funding will be set aside to fund operations of the RHC." No other specification was provided in the MC+ Demonstration proposal or approval language concerning this expenditure.

The types of St. Louis Regional Health Commission (SLRHC) expenditures under the Gateway to Better Health Demonstration are similar to the ones supported under the previously approved Demonstration. In both cases, the waiver funding was only a portion of the SLRHC budget. The SLRHC expenditures under the Gateway to Better Health Demonstration are expected to be consistent with SLRHC FY08 expenditures, as excerpted directly from the SLRHC 2008 year-end financial statements, as follows:

The SLRHC will continue to secure additional resources from local governments and private sources for those annual expenditures of SLRHC over \$300,000 during the demonstration period.

Response: The State is not seeking full funding for each entity/program under the proposed Demonstration, and the above table accurately captures approximate percentages of expenditures requested during the Demonstration. Notes have been added to the table to clarify the funding regarding St. Louis Connect Care.

The tracking of funds is captured through annual data provided to the Regional Health Commission and State that includes the number of uninsured patients seen at ConnectCare, Grace Hill, and Myrtle Hilliard Davis. This data is reviewed by the State and SLRHC at publicly open meetings of the Commission. In the first year of the Demonstration Project,

additional data would be collected by site as part of the pilot project's goal to transition the St. Louis model to a coverage model by 2014.

3. Voucher Services: Please clarify whether the outpatient voucher from St. Louis ConnectCare includes any costs that an individual must pay out of his/her own pocket, such as part of a sliding fee? Or, are any sliding fee contributions separate from the voucher amount?

Response: All services provided at ConnectCare, including outpatient vouchers, are accessible through a sliding fee scale, both to increase access for low-income patients and to prevent misuse of limited resources by patients with the ability to pay.

Patients who qualify for the sliding fee scale are billed for a percentage of the bill by ConnectCare for hospital or ancillary services, based upon ability to pay. Patients below 100% of the federal poverty level do not receive a bill. Patient responsibility may be further reduced on a case-by-case basis based on extenuating circumstances, such as an extended hospital stay or an expensive battery of tests.

Sliding fee payments are not remitted by ConnectCare to other providers once received.

ConnectCare's current sliding fee schedule for 2009-2010 is:

4. Community Referral Coordinator Program: We understand that Missouri received a nocost extension of the remaining \$170,910.48 of its Medicaid Emergency Room Diversion Grant through April 15, 2011. Has the State already spent the remaining \$170,910.84 on the project? If not, when does the State expect to spend the \$170,910.84?

On page 7 of the proposal, the State notes that \$510,980 was directed to the St. Louis Integrated Health Network for the Community Referral Coordinator Program (total over two years). Therefore, it appears it cost approximately \$255,490 each year (\$510,980/2 = \$255,490) to run the program in three hospitals. Based on the State's March 31, 2010 response, it appears the State expects it will cost a total of \$700,000 to operate the program in seven hospitals.

Please confirm that the State expects the program to cost an additional \$444,510 (\$700,000 - \$255,490) to be able to operate in four additional hospitals. If possible, please share how much it costs to run the program in each hospital.

Please confirm whether the seven hospitals that would participate in the Community Referral Coordinator Program are within the ConnectCare system.

Response: As of April 30, 2010, the State will have spent all of the remaining \$170,910.84 of its Medical Room Emergency Room Diversion Grant with the exception of \$108,507 remaining that is designated specifically for evaluation purposes only. These remaining funds will be expended by April 2011.

The total amount of expenses in calendar year 2009 for the Community Referral Coordinator (CRC) program was \$317,375. The program was operational in two hospitals (Barnes/Jewish and St. Mary's) in 2009, with expansion to the third hospital, St. Louis University Hospital, on January 4, 2010. Therefore, the total cost per hospital to operate the CRC program in 2009 was \$158,687.50 (\$317,375/2=\$158,687.50).

The State expects the program to cost \$700,000 annually to operate in seven hospitals during the five year demonstration, or \$100,000 per hospital. The "per hospital" cost to operate the CRC program will be less under the Demonstration Project than the previous pilot as the fixed costs of the program (i.e. program director, evaluation costs) are "spread" over a greater number of hospitals that will be operational.

The seven participating hospitals are all located in St. Louis' areas of highest need. The additional hospitals to be added to the CRC program were chosen due to the large number of Medicaid and uninsured ED visits made annually to those institutions, and include:

These hospitals actively partner with St. Louis ConnectCare and other community health centers to coordinate care for the uninsured and underinsured in the region.

5. **Pilot Program:** Please provide additional information on the pilot program. It is not clear what would be proposed under the pilot program. Is the State considering moving to a claims-based system of reimbursement? What types of services/activities is the State proposing to receive Federal matching funds for under this pilot program? Would the State please share whether the enactment of health care reform has affected the State's proposal and/or plans for the pilot program?

Response: The Department of Social Services, MO HealthNet Division and the SLRHC have a unique opportunity to partner together in designing a pilot program designed to move uninsured individuals to health care coverage. The passage of health care reform legislation gives the affiliated partners in the State's largest metropolitan area, where more than 40% of the city's residents are functionally illiterate, the ability to focus and design outreach and communication to link individuals to health care coverage and a medical home.

Once the demonstration program is approved, the State and the SLRHC will design a cost effective pilot to expand health care access to an additional 2% of the uninsured population each year of the demonstration and transition to a more "insurance like program." The following steps will be undertaken by the SLRHC:

- A. Develop a project management work plan in conjunction with stakeholders with project milestones within three months of the demonstration's approval (for review and approval by the State and the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS));
- B. Develop a focused outreach and communication strategy along with supporting materials to link uninsured individuals to medical homes using Referral Coordinators;
- C. Target uninsured individuals in coordination with the State, e.g. young adults "aging" out of Medicaid to ensure continuity of care until health care coverage is available under the new reform legislation;
- D. Expand access to the uninsured by 2% each year until 2014;
- E. Identify and design data methodologies to collect data to determine the cost of an ambulatory health care package including specialty services provided by the affiliated partners within the region;
- F. Conduct a thorough analysis of the data collected from year 1 during year 2 to determine the cost of health care:
- G. Work with and educate providers and consumers to prepare for implementation of coverage model in 2014.

This demonstration project gives not only the partners in Missouri but also CMS a unique learning experience to leverage a mature healthcare safety net system of care and corresponding infrastructure to review and evaluate effective outreach and communication strategies to the uninsured while linking them to medical homes; and, the ability to examine the cost of care when transitioning providers from a subsidy-based reimbursement model to a fee-based model. This effort will result in the development of tools and strategies to assist the state and other interested parties in transitioning uninsured individuals to health care coverage in cost effective ways while maintaining critical safety net infrastructure to ensure access when the numbers of individuals eligible for coverage are increased in an historically underserved urban area. Many of the tools and the strategies could be replicated and deployed in other health care service delivery areas. The St. Louis Model can and should be used to inform others efforts in building infrastructure and strategies to serve individuals transitioning to coverage under health care reform.

Follow-Up Funding/Financing Questions

Summary: The proposed section 1115 demonstration seeks \$30 million (total computable) of the State's Medicaid disproportionate share hospital (DSH) allotment to be diverted to support primary and specialty care clinics serving Medicaid patients and the uninsured in St. Louis. The non-Federal share of the proposed demonstration payments would come from the City of St. Louis and from State funds raised by the State's hospital provider tax. The requested funding for the proposed demonstration is estimated to represent one-third of the operating revenue to support direct care for the uninsured in St. Louis City and County and the administrative expenses of the Commission in overseeing and allocating funds to safety net providers.

In the State's revised budget neutrality worksheets (Appendix 5) submitted on March 15, 2010, the State estimates that Medicaid DSH payments would be \$732,605,968 (total computable) annually or \$3,663,029,840 (total computable) over the five year period *without* the Demonstration. *With* the proposed Demonstration, DSH payments would decrease by \$30 million each year to \$702,605,968 (total computable) annually or \$3,513,029,840 (total computable) over the five year period. \$150,000,000 (total computable) would be available to support primary and specialty care services through the section 1115 demonstration.

On pages 2 and 5 of the February 16, 2010 section 1115 demonstration proposal, the State indicates that Missouri hospitals funded the \$30 million to support the primary and specialty care network after the expiration of the section 1115 demonstration in 2007, presumably for SFYs 2008, 2009, and 2010.

Additionally, in Appendix 3 – Affiliation Report to the St. Louis Regional Health Commission and St. Louis Regional DSH Funding Authority, Exhibits A and B display "DSH Funding" as a type of revenue for all three "affiliation partners" Statement of Revenue and Expenses.

We have the following questions regarding Medicaid DSH payments and the financing of the affiliation partners:

1. Page 6 of the February 16, 2010 section 1115 demonstration proposal references the "St. Louis Safety Net Funding Pool." Please identify and describe the source of the funds that comprised this pool for SFYs 2008, 2009, and 2010. In the description, please also indicate whether all or a portion of these funds were derived from Medicaid DSH payments.

Response: The funding was donated by the Missouri Hospital Association from contributions from its members. The State does not know which hospitals contributed or the amounts contributed.

2. Page 6 of the February 16, 2010 section 1115 demonstration proposal references the "St. Louis Regional DSH Funding Authority." Please identify and describe the source of the funds that were distributed to "the affiliation partners" in SFYs 2008, 2009, and 2010. In the

description, please also indicate whether all or a portion of these funds were derived from Medicaid DSH payments.

Response: The Regional DSH Funding Authority is the entity that distributes the funds in the Safety Net Funding Pool. It is not a state entity. See answer #1 above.

3. If the funding in questions 1 or 2, above was derived from Medicaid DSH payments, please indicate whether or not the participating hospitals were required to direct their payment to either the "St. Louis Safety Net Funding Pool," the "St. Louis Regional DSH Funding Authority," or any other related entity for SFYs 2008, 2009, or 2010.

Response: The contributions were arranged between the Missouri Hospital Association and its members. The State neither mandated nor requested the contributions.

4. If the funding in questions 1 or 2, above, was derived from Medicaid DSH payments, please identify the hospitals that provided such funding for SFYs 2008, 2009, and 2010.

Response: The State does not have this information.

5. Section 1923(g) of the Social Security Act establishes hospital-specific DSH limits for DSH payments at the uncompensated cost incurred in providing inpatient and outpatient hospital services to Medicaid patients and individuals with no source of third party coverage. For SFYs 2008, 2009, and 2010, please provide the total amount of DSH payments made to each hospital identified in question 4, above, and provide the 1923(g) hospital-specific DSH limit for each hospital.

Response: All payments to Missouri hospitals were made in compliance with Section 1923(g) according to the methodology set forth in the state plan. Any contributions by hospitals through the MHA are not part of the DSH calculation. Please see Attachment 1.

6. The without waiver base line projects annual DSH payments of \$732,695,968 between 2011 and 2015. In projecting this level of spending, did the State take into consideration any potential impact from the DSH audits required under section 1923(j) of the Act and implementing regulations?

Response: The audits are ongoing and the State does not know what the impact of the audits will be. Historically the hospitals have had uncompensated costs in excess of the DSH allotment. See exhibits provided in response to #5.

7. On page 4 of the February 16, 2010 proposal, the State indicates that if the demonstration proposal is not funded, residents served through the network of clinics will be forced to go

through hospital emergency rooms and clinics at much higher costs, or go without needed services. Would the State please quantify the cost differential between the two service models?

Response: According to the data collected by SLRHC several years ago, it is approximately three times more expensive for an individual to go to an ER rather than a SLRHC clinic for a non-emergency service. This differential does not including professional fees, which can increase the disparity even further. According to a recent survey conducted by Medical Triage Innovation and provided to the State, the costs of an ER visit can range from \$800 to over \$3000, as opposed to a primary care visit which costs \$75 to \$120.

Putting the cost differential aside, there is also a significant human and social cost. The hospital ERs are not easily accessed by the community served by the SLRHC providers, and primary and preventative care is not available through the ER. According to the same Medical Triage Innovation study, patients who access their primary care through the ER rather than a clinic are substantially more likely to have poor health consequences.

Finally, the State believes that substantial costs would have to be incurred in re-developing and re-staffing the SLRHC network in 2014, once universal coverage is mandated, if funding is not available during this transition period.
