Comparison to Governor's Recommended Budget

- MHD Supplemental reduced by \$15.6 million state share funds related to more current projections
- \$350 million in additional federal authority related to Families First Act Enhanced Federal Match
- \$266 million in additional federal and other funds authority

MO HealthNet (MHD) Budget Truly Agreed and Finally Passed (TAFP) State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2021

Comparison to Governor's Recommended Budget

- MHD Cost to Continue reduced by \$38.1 million state share funds related to more current projections
- Premium Buy In reduced \$2.8 million state share related to updated information
- MMIS items not funded include the Claims Transaction updates, Security Risk Assessment, and Electronic Premium Collections
- Pharmacy Specialty Increase and Asset Limit Phase-In funded at half the Governor's Recommended amount
- Nursing Facility Capital Investment Cost to Continue not funded
- CCBHO Expansion and Quality Incentive Payments not funded
- Ground Ambulance Rate Increase added
- FRA Increase added related to additional Disproportionate Share payments in FY21
