New Initiatives or events

- o Molina achieved NCQA accreditation at a Commendable status.
- o Implemented IVR process for notifying members about health education events.
- o Materials related to RSV were mailed to members at high risk and posted to the Molina website. An article was included in the Fall member newsletter.
- o Molina has outreached to network providers with diabetic Molina members by providing reminders for the Comprehensive Diabetes Care HEDIS sub-measure screenings.
- o Molina disseminated new resources for Chlamydia screening to providers.
- o Implemented a flu initiative campaign.

- o Through September, Molina facilitated back-to-school events that involved well check-up screenings and dental screenings across all three regions.
