# MO HealthNet Meeting Action Items

## Update on Pending Actions (see minutes):

  - Tobacco shortfall: Office of Administration estimate of allocation (p.2)

  - General revenue \$303 million vs. total \$795 million timeline (p.2)
- Managed Care Value
  - 7% increase explanation from Mercer (p.3)

# Enrollment

- Change in MOHealthNET Enrollment
  - Total Enrollment, January 2019: **904,679**
  - Total Enrollment, January 2018: **977,531**
    - Drop of -72,852 (-7.5%)
- Over 57,000 of the enrollment drop is children
  - (-57,840: about 80% of the drop, drop of -9.3%)
- Lowest enrollment in MO HealthNET since February 2015
  - 2015 was the last time enrollment in Missouri Medicaid dipped below 900,000
