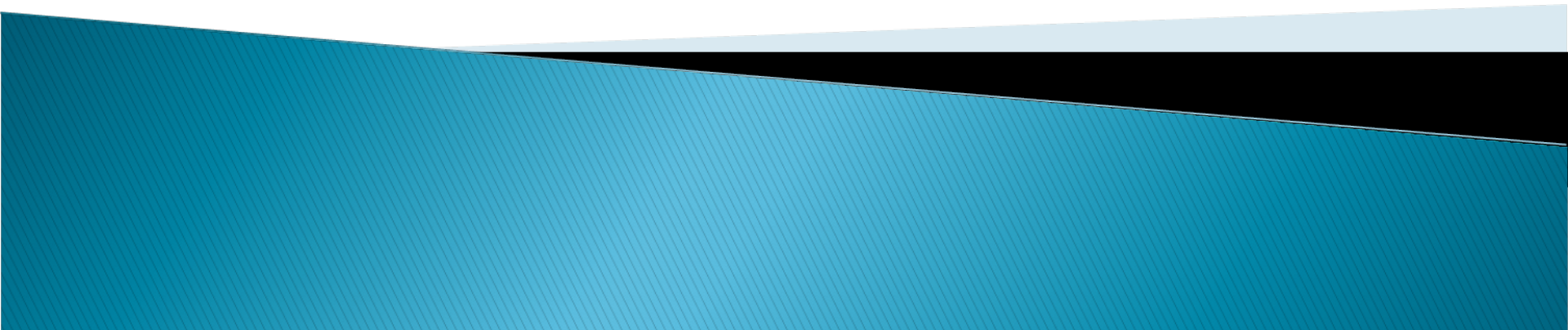


Health Home Update



Overview

- ▶ Two Medicaid Health Home initiatives– primary care and mental health
 - Partnership between MO HealthNet and Department of Mental Health
 - Collaboration with Missouri Primary Care Association (MPCA) and Missouri Hospital Association (MHA)
- ▶ Multipayer Initiative coordinated by Missouri Foundation for Health (MFH)
- ▶ One Learning Collaborative for all participants
 - Collaboration between MFH, Health Care Foundation of Greater Kansas City, MPCA, and MHA


Primary Care Health Home Basics

- ▶ Eligible individuals have at least two of the following:
 - Asthma
 - Cardiovascular disease
 - Diabetes
 - Developmental disabilities
 - Overweight (BMI > 25) OR
- ▶ One of the above and tobacco use
- ▶ Diabetes as single condition


Primary Care Health Home Basics

- ▶ Eligible Health Home Providers:
 - FQHC's
 - RHC's
 - Primary care clinics operated by hospitals


Primary Care Health Home Basics

- ▶ Practice site physician or nurse practitioner–led
 - ▶ Health Team
 - Primary care physician or nurse practitioner
 - Behavioral health consultant
 - Nurse care manager
 - Care Coordinator
 - Others per practice

Initial Provider Qualifications

- ▶ Substantial percentage of patients enrolled in Medicaid (> 25%)
 - ▶ Special consideration to those with considerable volume of needy individuals
 - ▶ Strong, engaged, committed leadership
 - ▶ Meet state requirements for patient empanelment
- 


Initial Provider Qualifications

- ▶ Meet state's minimum access requirement including enhanced access requirement
 - ▶ Have a formal and regular process for patient input
 - ▶ Have completed EMR implementation/use EMR for at least 6 months prior to beginning health home services
 - ▶ Actively use MHD EHR for care coordination & Rx monitoring


Initial Provider Qualifications

- ▶ Utilize interoperable registry
 - Input annual metabolic screening results
 - Track/measure care
 - Automate care reminders
 - Produce exception reports
- ▶ MOU with regional hospital or system within 3 months health home service implementation


Application Process

- ▶ 29 Applications, 110 sites
 - ▶ 70 FQHC's
 - ▶ 1 independent RHC
 - ▶ 22 public hospital-based RHC or clinic
 - ▶ 16 private hospital-based RHC or clinic

Application Process

- ▶ Applications reviewed and scored
 - ▶ Site visits made
 - ▶ Follow up phone calls to sites with questions about application
 - ▶ Final Applicant Review meeting
 - ▶ Finalization of participating organizations
- 

Core Technical Steps

- ▶ Determination of number of eligibles
 - Initial population of 25,000 patients
 - ▶ Finalization of staffing model
 - ▶ Determination of PMPM
 - ▶ Finalization of Measures
 - ▶ Cost savings estimate
 - ▶ Cost impact estimate
 - ▶ IT/Systems building to accommodate health home initiative

Next Steps

- ▶ CMHC State Plan Amendment approved by CMS
 - Will begin health home services in January
- ▶ Primary Care Health Home State Plan Amendment submitted to CMS
 - Anticipate beginning health home services in January as well
