


# Did You or a Member of Your Household Receive Medicaid in 2015?



If you did, you should receive IRS Form **1095-B** in the Mail

## What is the 1095-B

Form 1095-B proves you had Medicaid (MO HealthNet or CHIP) for at least part of one month during 2015. Separate forms will be sent for each household member who received Medicaid.

- The information on Form 1095-B is used to determine whether you and your dependents have met the minimum health coverage requirements under the Affordable Care Act.
- **Receiving a 1095-B form does not mean you are required to file a tax return with the IRS.**

If you do not receive a 1095-B form, you can request a copy by calling

If you received a 1095-B, but feel the information is incorrect, call 1-800-407-9890.

## How to Use Form 1095-B

- Keep this form in a safe place with your other important papers!
- If you use a tax professional to prepare your tax return, they may ask to see your 1095-B along with your other tax information.
- You are not required to send the 1095-B form with your tax return.
