Overview Show-Me Healthy Babies (SMHB) Program

Eligibility guidelines for the Show-Me Healthy Babies program are:

Pregnancy;

- Missouri residency;
- Household income must be at or below 305% of FPL;
- Uninsured
- No access to employer insurance_or affordable private insurance_which includes maternity benefits; and
- Pregnant woman cannot be eligible for any other MO HealthNet programs (with the exception of Uninsured Women's Health services, Extended Women's Health Services, or Gateway to better Health).

Procedure for processing applications:

- A MO HealthNet application is received and processed;
- If denied due to excess income or not being a citizen or qualified alien, application is screen for SMHB eligibility criteria;
- Household income is entered in the SMHB calculator to determine income eligibility;
- If eligible, SMHB coverage is entered into MEDES, notice of approval is mailed to individual, and MO HealthNet card issued;
- If not eligible, notice of denial is mailed to individual.

Applications to Date (since 1/4/16 start date):

- 110 applications received
 - o 52 approved
 - o 6 rejected
 - o 46 pending evidence
 - o 6 in error -- should have been MPW applications
