<b>ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>Active MO HealthNet status, and eligible for PC services</b></li> <li>▪ <b>Must have impairments and unmet needs</b></li> <li>▪ <b>Birth to age 21, based on medical necessity</b> - authorized by Bureau of Special Health Care Needs (BSHN) for participants in Healthy Children &amp; Youth (HCY) program</li> <li>▪ <b>Aged and disabled, ages 18-59, and age 60 and over with Nursing Home level of care</b> - authorized by Division of Senior &amp; Disability Services (DSDS)</li> <li>▪ <b>Consumer Directed Services (CDS)</b> - at least 18 years of age; physically disabled; able to self-direct; capable of living independently with CDS; meet Nursing Home level of care</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>Active MO HealthNet status, and eligible for PDN services</b></li> <li>• <b>Under the age of 21</b></li> <li>• <b>Eligible for HCY services</b></li> <li>• <b>Authorized by BSHCN, in accordance with a plan of care</b></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Active MO HealthNet status, and eligible for HH services</b></li> <li>• <b>Require medically-oriented treatment or supervision, due to an acute illness or injury which can be therapeutically managed at home</b></li> </ul>
<b>SERVICES PROVIDED</b>	<p><b>May be authorized as agency-model or consumer-directed model</b></p> <p><b>Basic and Advanced Personal Care services</b> - performed by an aide</p> <p><b>Basic Personal Care</b> – <i>Examples: Planning, preparing, and clean-up of meals; Making beds and changing sheets; Brushing/combing and shampooing hair; Shopping for groceries/household items specifically required for participant’s health and maintenance</i></p> <p><b>Advanced Personal Care</b> – <i>Examples: Using lift or other device for transfers; Manually assisting with oral medications set up by a nurse</i></p> <p><b>Authorized Nurse Visits</b></p> <p><b>Personal Care Assistance</b></p> <p><b>Consumer-Directed Services (CDS)</b></p>	<p><b>Professional nursing services</b> - in the home on more than a part-time or intermittent basis</p> <p><b>Performed by RN or LPN</b> (LPN must have training documented by RN)</p>	<p><b>Skilled Nursing</b> – provided by or under supervision of a RN; <i>Examples: Initial evaluation and regular re-evaluation of nursing needs; Preparing clinical assessment documentation; Coordinating services; Informing physician of changes in condition and needs; Counseling patient and family in meeting nursing needs; Participating in in-service programs</i></p> <p><b>Medical Supplies</b> – items that enable HH personnel to conduct home visits or effectively perform ordered care</p> <p><b>Home Health Aide services</b> – provided under direction and supervision of a RN or therapist; Simple procedures performed as extension of therapy services, personal care, and household services essential to health care at home</p> <p><b>Physical Therapy *</b></p> <p><b>Occupational Therapy *</b></p> <p><b>Speech Therapy *</b></p> <p><i>*Not covered for individuals with limited benefit packages, with exception of Expanded Adult Group</i></p>
