Value Based Payments (continued)

DD TCM providers are eligible for a value based payment (VBP) when DD TCM staff serving in the role of the Health Risk Screening Tool (HRST) rater are engaged in completing the Electronic MO Person Centered Thinking (PCT) training. The performance period shall be a state fiscal year (7/1 – 6/30) starting state fiscal year 2024. The VBP is a standardized one-time payment rate of \$1,196.00 to the TCM agency for each staff serving in the role of the MO HRST Rater that completes the designated Electronic MO PCT training prior to the end of state fiscal year 2024. The VBP payment will be disbursed within 6 months following the end of state fiscal year 2024.

DD TCM providers are eligible for a VBP when DD TCM staff serving in the role of the HRST rater are engaged in completing the Fatal Five for Case Managers training in the electronic system. The performance period shall be a state fiscal year (7/1 – 6/30) starting state fiscal year 2024. The VBP is a standardized one-time payment rate of \$520.00 to the TCM agency for each assigned staff serving in the role MO HRST Rater that completes the designated Fatal Five for Case Managers training prior to the end of state fiscal year 2024. The VBP payment will be disbursed within 6 months following the end of state fiscal year 2024.

**Method for establishing payment rates for case management services for Severely Emotionally Disturbed (SED) children**

The state agency will reimburse Targeted Case Management providers at fee-for-service rates. The state payment for each service will be the lower of:

- (1) The provider's actual charge for the service; or
- (2) The Medicaid maximum allowable amount per unit of service.

A single rate is established for each unit of service. Except as otherwise noted in the plan, state-developed fee schedule rates are the same for both governmental and private providers of rehabilitative services offered by TCM providers (as detailed in Section 3.1-A of the state plan). The TCM procedure codes and the Medicaid fee schedule are published on the MO HealthNet website at <https://dss.mo.gov/mhd/providers/fee-for-service-providers.htm> and are effective for services provided on or after July 1, 2022.
