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Opting Out of the Managed Care Program

You may choose to be in the MO HealthNet Fee-for-Service program instead of the Managed Care program if you:

- Are eligible for Supplemental Security Income (SSI) benefits
- Children who are enrolled in the Special Health Care Needs program
- Are disabled and 18 or younger

***Note:** Health plans should not encourage you to opt out instead of delivering health plan benefits. Please call MO HealthNet Constituent Services at (573) 526-4274 to report if a health plan encourages you to opt-out.

You have the right to get one free copy of the medical record annually by contacting your Managed Care health plan:
