

Premiums for American Indian or Native Alaskan Tribe Members*

How does this change my child's premium?

If your child is a member of a federally-recognized American Indian or Native Alaskan tribe, you do not have to pay a premium for your child's healthcare coverage.

How do I stop paying premiums?

You will need to send a copy of proof of your child's tribal membership to the **Premium Collections Unit** by mail, fax, or email.

Be sure to include your child's name and MO HealthNet identification number.

What counts as proof of membership?

To prove your child's tribal membership, please send us one of the following:

- A copy of a tribal membership card
- A letter issued by a tribe that is recognized by the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs
