Chiropractic Medicine Effective January 1, 2020

13.70 CHIROPRACTIC MEDICINE

13.70.A COVERED SERVICES

Chiropractic services are limited to examinations, diagnoses, adjustments, manipulations and treatments of malpositioned articulations, and structures of the body provided by licensed chiropractic physicians practicing within their scope of practice.

13.70.B ELIGIBLE PROVIDERS

- Provider must be licensed to practice chiropractic by complying with the provisions of Chapter 331, RSMo
- Have signed a participation agreement to provide chiropractic services under the MO HealthNet program.

13.70.C ELIGIBLE PARTICIPANTS

• MO HealthNet Eligible

13.70.D LIMITATIONS

 Participants may receive up to 20 visits per year for chiropractic services. <u>{11/06/19 per policy: 20 visits per ROLLING year}</u>

Chiropractic Credentials

A MO HealthNet enrolled Physician who is licensed to provide Chiropractic services, [2 separate licenses] can enroll under two provider types; provider type 20 for physician **and** provider type 23 for chiropractor.

Should provider choose to use the same NPI they would supply a separate taxonomy code for each provider type or they obtain a separate NPI for each in which case taxonomy codes are not required.

Chiropractic Credentials (cont.)

Chiropractors currently can enroll as a Qualified Medicare Beneficiary (QMB) provider type 75 and specialty 35. However, should they wish to enroll under the 23 provider type they will need to do one of the following:

- Dis-enroll their currently enrolled 75 number or;
- Enroll with a new National Provider Identifier (NPI) for their 23 provider # or;
- If the provider is enrolling under the same NPI as the QMB enrollment, a different taxonomy code is required for each.

Provider Enrollment

If a qualified provider is not already enrolled with the MHD as a provider, an enrollment application must be submitted. The link to compete the electronic application is:
