
# **Start Smart for Baby (SSFB)**

**Goal:** Aims to reduce pregnancy complications, premature deliveries, low birth weight, and other poor outcomes in babies.

The SSFB program identifies pregnant members through assessments, claims data, state eligibility data, and referrals. One of the essential components of the program is the Notification of Pregnancy (NOP), which identifies risk factors as early in pregnancy as possible to establish a relationship between the member, provider, and health plan team.

Care Managers engage and empower members in accessing <u>medical and behavioral</u> healthcare, wellness programs, additional health benefits, and educational resources to fully equip them to manage their health leading up to delivery.

## **NICU Care Management**

**NICU Care Management** is available for all members. Specialized nurses will follow baby from admission to NICU through to discharge. Nurses will assist with discharge planning to assure smooth transition from hospital to home.

## **Children's Trust Fund**

Connecting pregnant foster youth to home visiting services through their Show Me Healthy Kids health plan will improve outcomes in health, safety, education, and economic mobility for Missouri's most vulnerable mothers and babies.

### How does the Coordinated Referral & Intake System work?

- Home State Health staff will contact the foster youth to inform them of prenatal services available through their health plan.
- Staff will offer to make a home visiting referral with the youth's informed consent.
- With consent, staff will make a home visiting referral through the Coordinated Referral & Intake System(CRIS) to connect with a local home visiting provider
- The referral will be steered toward intensive or evidence based home visiting that meets the unique needs of the pregnant foster youth

# **Transportation**



If you have MO HealthNet (Medicaid) Managed Care benefits from Home State Health and are eligible for the transportation benefit,\* you can use Rideshare, such as Lyft or Uber, to get to and from your doctor appointments, lab tests, therapy appointments and any other non-emergency medical appointment.



Rideshare delivers short wait times, outstanding service, ride tracking and better access to healthcare services.

If you have an emergency, call 911, and/or go to the nearest emergency department, even if it is not in the Home State Health network.

Home State Health offers multiple trips that allow a parent transportation from home to pick up children at school and then on to doctor appointments.




# My Health Pays

#### START EARNING TODAY!

- \$30 Seasonal Flu Vaccine. September-April. Individuals can receive up to two vaccines per calendar year.
- \$10 Completion of Health Risk Assessment. Within 30 days of enrollment. Call 1-855-694-HOME (4663) (TDD/TTY1-877-250-6113) to complete the assessment.
- \$25 Well Care Visit With Your Assigned Primary Care Doctor. Within 90 days of enrollment.
- \$25 Completion of At Least 3 Health Coaching Calls. Per Calendar Year. You must be assigned to case management for asthma, depression and/or diabetes to be eligible for this reward.
- \$10 Participation in 2 Tobacco-Free Counseling Sessions In A Calendar Year. Age 18 and up.
- \$25 Annual Well Care Visit With Your Assigned Primary Care Doctor. Age 22 and up.
- \$30 Annual Comprehensive Diabetes Care.

  Age 18-75. Must complete all of the following once in the calendar year.
  - HbA1c test
  - Kidney screening
  - · LDL-cholesterol screening
  - Retinopathy screening (dilated eye exam)

- \$10 Completion of a Behavioral Health Office Visit within 7 Days of Discharge from a Behavioral Health Inpatient Admission. Applies to members who were hospitalized for treatment of selected mental illnesses.
- \$10 Annual Chlamydia Screening. Age 16-24. One per calendar year.
- \$10 Cervical Cancer Screening.
  Age 21-64. One screening in a 3-year period.
- \$10 Annual Breast Cancer Screening Age 40-74. One per calendar year.
- \$10 For Every 3rd Prenatal Doctor Visit\*.
- \$10 Postpartum Doctor Visit.\* Within 30 days of delivery.
- \$25 Annual Well Care Visit With Your Assigned Primary Care Doctor. Age 2-21.
- \$25 Annual Dental Visit. Age 2-21.
- \$10 Lead Screening Test. Must be completed before child's second birthday. Once per lifetime.
- \$15 COVID-19 Vaccine. Eligible members who receive their COVID-19 vaccination shot(s).


To earn rewards, member claims for healthy activity completion must be processed by Home State Health.


\*To be eligible for this reward, you must notify us you are pregnant prior to having your baby by calling us or submitting a completed Notification of Pregnancy (NOP) form.

#### **Secure Health Information**

Home State Health will be adding future enhancements to our health information system to continuously help serve as a community health record for enrollees.

Currently, through the HSH secure portal, providers can:

- View the PCP panel (patient list)
- Check member eligibility
- View Members' health record
- View member gaps in care
- Review Provider/Patient Analytics (quality scorecard including loyalty and risk scores)
- View and submit claims and adjustments
- View payment history
- View and submit prior authorizations
- View and submit Notification of Pregnancy
- Submit demographic changes
- Contact us securely and confidentially


#### **Live Webinars:**
