Treat No Transport Services (TNT) Ambulance Manual Section 13.3.X

Effective January 1, 2020

Certain emergency services are covered when the participant is not transported to an emergency department. Reference Section 19 for the appropriate TNT procedure code.

On-Site Treatment, No Transport Ambulance Manual Section 13.3.X(1)

On-site treatment provided by a emergency medical technician or paramedic is covered if the service meets the following criteria:

- 1. Is the result of an emergent or immediate response made by a licensed ambulance service;
- 2. The ambulance provider performs a medically necessary assessment;
- 3. Treatment is provided to the participant; and
- 4. The participant is *not* transported by the responding service provider to an emergency department.

On-Site Treatment, No Transport Ambulance Manual Section 13.3.X(2)

When an on-site referral for further treatment is provided to the participant, the service is covered if it meets the following criteria:

- 1. Is the result of an emergency or immediate response made by a licensed ambulance service;
- 2. The EMS crew provides a medically necessary assessment;
- 3. A referral for further treatment is provided to the participant; and
- 4. The participant is *not* transported by the responding service provider to an emergency department.

Procedure Code: A0998

Ambulance Response/Treatment/Referral Current allowable amount: \$152.00

Maximum Quantity- 1 per day
