

Post-Award Public Input Forum Notice
Public Hearing Concerning Missouri’s Gateway to Better Health Section 1115
Demonstration Project Number: 11-W-00250/7

On September 1, 2017, The State of Missouri, Department of Social Services (DSS), received a five-year extension of its Gateway to Better Health Demonstration from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). The Gateway to Better Health Demonstration provides coverage for certain outpatient care to low-income, uninsured adults residing in St. Louis City and St. Louis County who do not qualify for Medicaid.

Under the terms of the extension, Gateway to Better Health provides primary and specialty care services to uninsured individuals, ages 19 through 64, with family incomes below 100 percent of the Federal poverty level (FPL). The program was originally approved in July 2010 and currently is scheduled to expire on December 31, 2022.
