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HB1414 Quarterly Reporting Format Changes

In accordance with 13 CSR 35-35.100(9)(B), the Children's Division has completed the required review and comment process regarding proposed amendments to the Quarterly Reporting format.

The Response and Evaluation (R&E) Team's notice and comment period concluded on January 8, 2026, and the public notice and comment period concluded on February 7, 2026. No R&E Team or public comments were received.

What is Changing

To enhance transparency, accessibility, and usability of performance data, the Division is implementing the following updates:

1. Transition of Data Tables to Public Dashboard

- Performance data, including Stakeholder Survey Response data and Child and Family Services Review data, previously presented in extensive written tables within the Quarterly Report will now be available through the Division's public-facing dashboard (launched October 31, 2025).
- The dashboard provides stakeholders and the public with a more user-friendly, interactive way to view performance metrics and trends over time.
- The Quarterly Report will continue to be published as required by rule; however, its focus will shift toward:
 - Analysis of performance data
 - Key findings and trends
 - Lessons learned and improvement efforts
- A direct link to the interactive dashboard will be included within each Quarterly Report.

2. Removal of Redundant Historical Narrative Sections

- Historical and background information previously included at the beginning of the Quarterly Report will be removed. This includes sections such as:
 - Introduction
 - HB1414 Metric Reporting Timeline
 - Evaluation Tool and Metrics
 - Foster Care Case Management Dashboard overview
 - Standardized Stakeholder Feedback Tool overview
- This information remains publicly available through the interactive dashboard and the House Bill 1414 website.

Effective Date

These reporting format changes will become effective on April 1, 2026, the first day of the calendar quarter following publication of this notice, consistent with 13 CSR 35-35.100(9)(B).

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
