PROPOSED RESCISSION

13 CSR 110-3.050 Instructions for the Implementation of Revocation Procedure. The division is rescinding this rule because the procedures are adequately addressed in 13 CSR 110-3.040.

PURPOSE: The purpose of this rule is to provide guidelines for the implementation of procedures to be followed in the revocation of aftercare supervision and return of the youth to an institution or a facility.

PUBLIC COST: The proposed rescission will not cost state agencies or political subdivisions more than five hundred dollars (\$500) in the aggregate.

PRIVATE COST: The proposed rescission will not cost private entities more than five hundred dollars (\$500) in the aggregate.
