

Figure 1. Regions




Figure 2. Reason for Child Care





Figure 3. Children Served by Facility

12-Month Average December 2022 - November 2023







Figure 4. Children Served by Provider

12-Month Average December 2022 - November 2023









Figure 6. Child Care Payments





12-Month Average December 2022 - November 2023






Figure 9. Children Served Age < 2 By Facility





Figure 10. Children Served Ages 2-5 By Facility

12-Month Average December 2022 - November 2023







Figure 11. Children Served Ages > 5 By Facility





Figure 12. Children Served in Center By Age





Figure 13. Children Served in Family Home By Age





Figure 14. Children Served in Group Home By Age

12-Month Average December 2022 - November 2023





Figure 15. Transitional Households by Level November 2023






Figure 16. Transitional Children by Level November 2023

12-Month Average December 2022 - November 2023







Figure 18. Child Care Providers By Type






Figure 20. Households by Reason for Care





Figure 21. Children by Reason for Care
