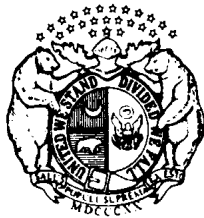

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Part I

Intensive In-home Services Statewide Overview

Introduction

The IIS Program

Families in crisis may be faced with the removal of a child or children from their home due to problems such as neglect, abuse, family violence, mental illness, delinquency, or other crisis circumstances. Intensive In-home Services (IIS) offers these families an alternative to the placement of children into out-of-home, alternative care. Referrals to IIS can be made 24 hours a day, seven days a week for the family in crisis. This intensive model of IIS means that a primary specialist from either DFS or a contracted vendor must be available to a family at any time during the intervention. Services must be flexible to meet the family's unique needs. The intervention is designed to be short-termed and home-based. The goal of these services is to manage the crisis and restore the family to an acceptable level of functioning so that the family can remain safely together.

Definitions

Families:

A Missouri family who has one or more children at-risk for removal from the home are eligible to receive IIS. Each IIS family is represented by a *head of household*.

At-risk children:

The children identified as at-risk for out-of-home placement are referred to as *at-risk children*.

Families and Children Accepted

During state fiscal year 2004 (July 1, 2003-June 30, 2004), the number of at-risk children accepted into IIS was 3,310. The total number of families accepted into IIS was 1,646 and the total number of children, including at-risk children, was 4,165. On average, families accepted into IIS were comprised of 2.5 total children and 2 at-risk children (Appendix A).

Families and Children Not Accepted

The 1,603 families not accepted for IIS during FY 2004 included 2,951 at-risk children (Appendices A and B). The most common reason (36%) that at-risk children were not accepted into IIS was due to lack of openings into the program with the children remaining at home.

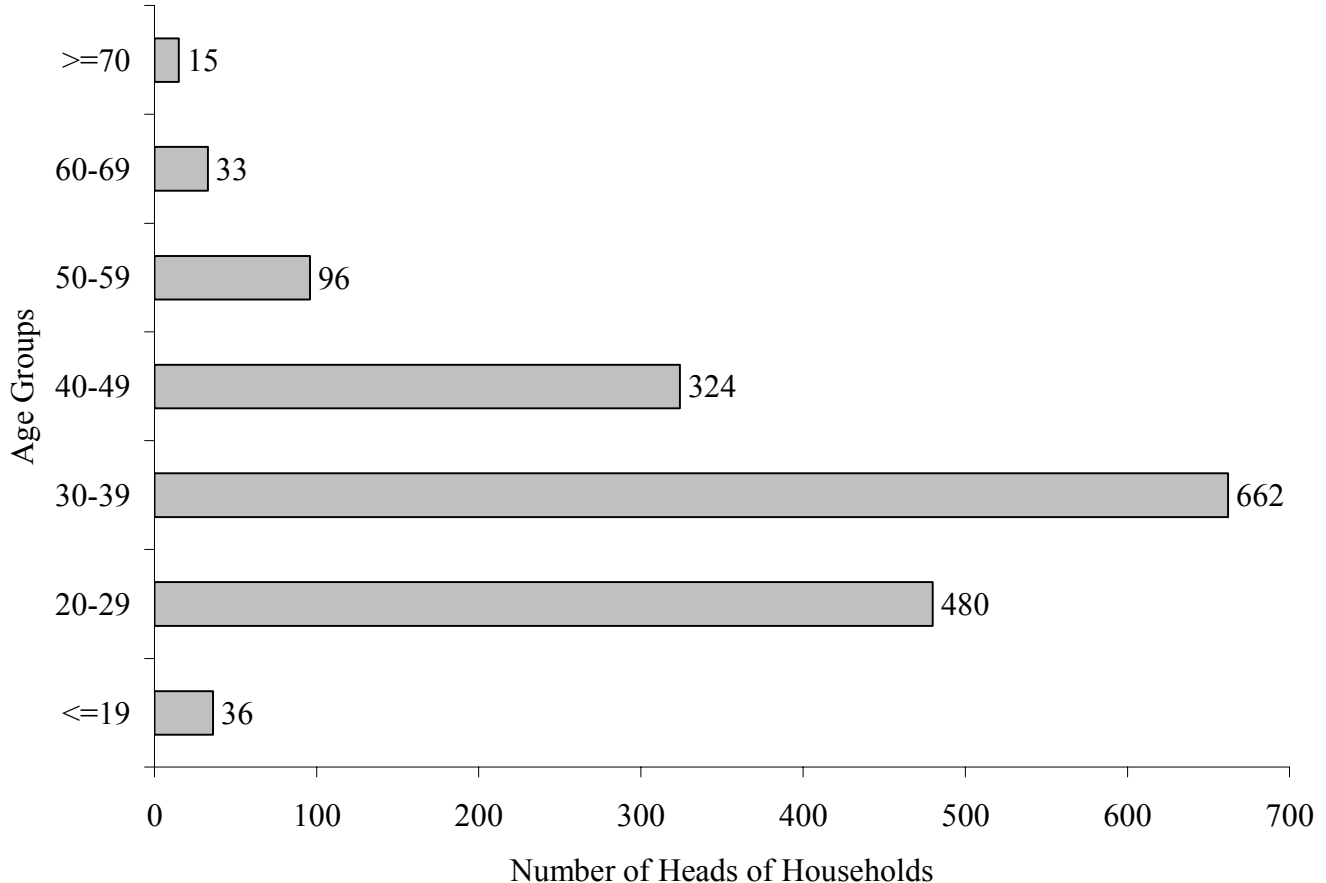

During FY 2004, the head of household was most likely to be in the age range of 30-39, female and white (Appendix D, Appendix E, and Appendix F).

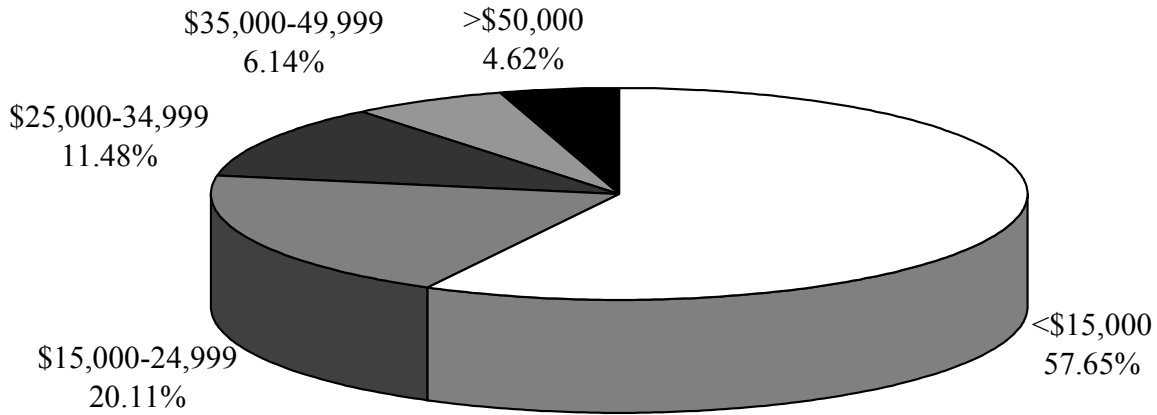

Age of Head of Household



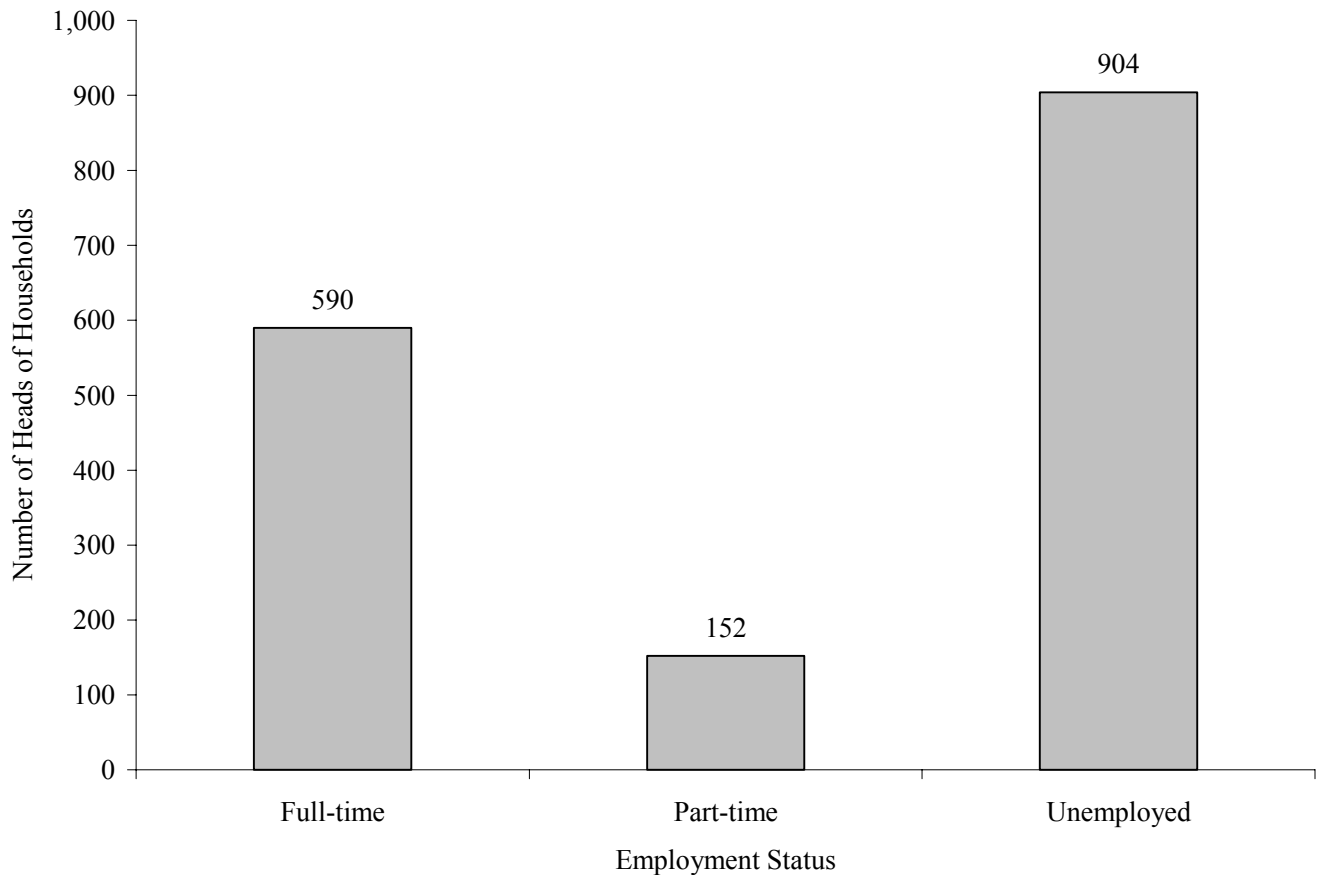

Fifty-eight percent of the heads of households earned incomes of less than \$15,000 and 64 percent were either unemployed or only employed part-time (Appendix H and Appendix G).

Head of Household Characteristics of Families Accepted (continued)

Sixty-five percent of the 1,646 heads of households required help with parenting skills problems during FY 2004. The next most frequently addressed head of household problem was parent/child conflict at 39 percent (636) followed by communication at 27 percent (444), child neglect at 23 percent (385), and mental health problems at 20 percent (331).

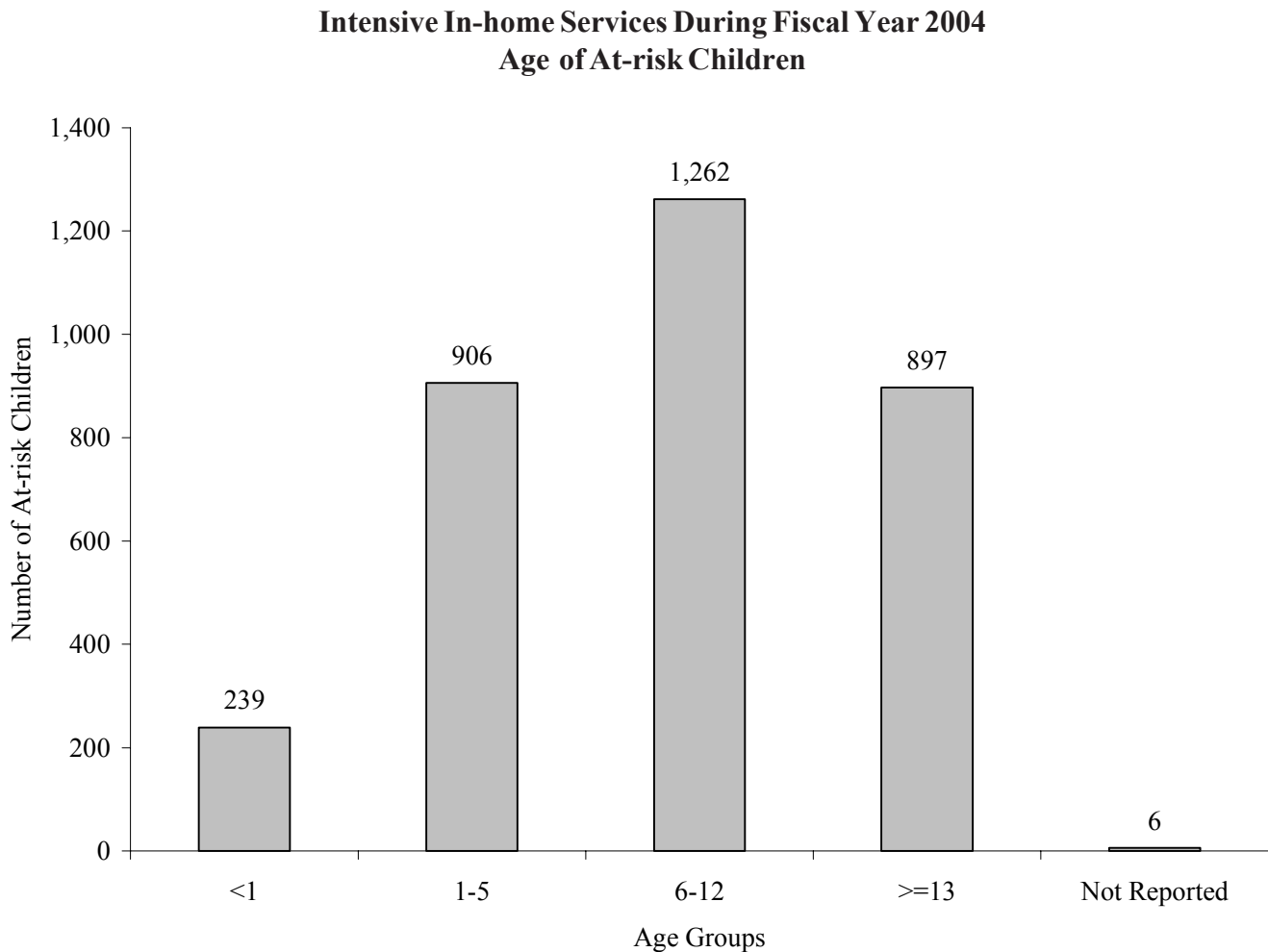

At-risk Children Characteristics of Families Accepted

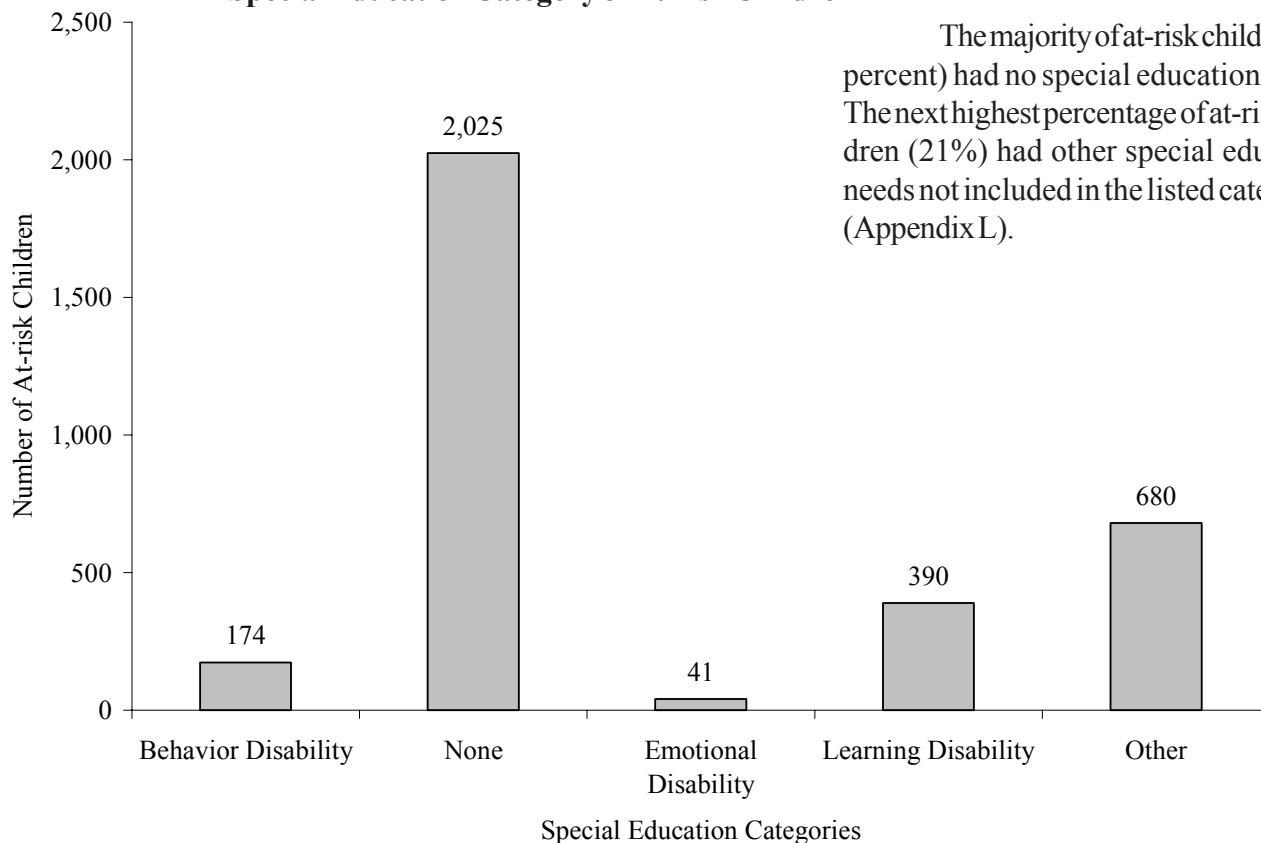
During FY 2004, at-risk children were more likely to be female than male at 52% versus 48%. Sixty-three percent of at-risk children were white, 34% were black and the remaining 3% were other races or not reported (Appendix J and Appendix K). Most at-risk children (38%) were six to twelve years old (Appendix I).

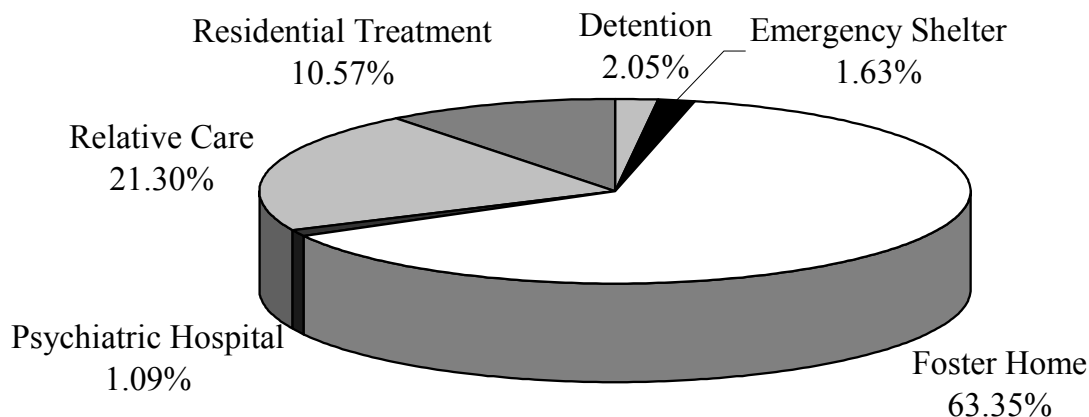


At-risk Children Characteristics of Families Accepted (continued)

Sixty-three percent of the at-risk children avoided placement into foster homes by receiving IIS. Without IIS, 21 percent of the at-risk children would have been placed with relatives, another 11 percent in residential placements, two percent in detention, two percent in emergency shelters and one percent in psychiatric hospitals (Appendix M).

At-risk Children Characteristics of Families Accepted (continued)

Thirty-four percent (1,131) of at-risk children had Parent/Child Conflict issues as the most common problem addressed in IIS during FY 2004. The next most common problems addressed were Parenting Skills Problems at 27 percent (908) and Other at 23 percent (750).

Prior Contacts

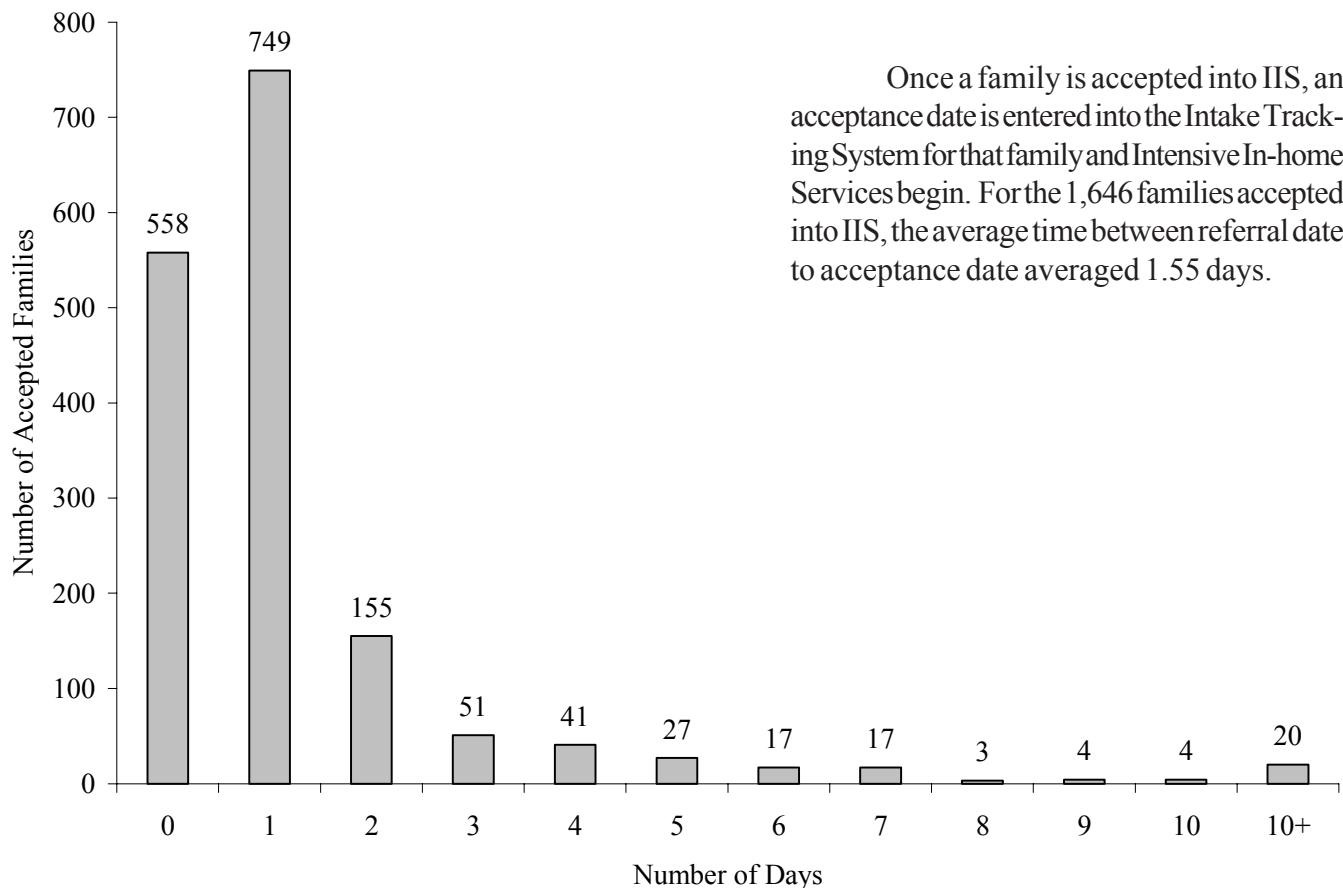
Of the 1,646 families accepted into IIS, 890 families had at least one contact with another agency prior to the IIS intervention. Those 890 families had a total of 1,479 prior contacts. Each family can have up to six prior contacts listed. Fifty-three percent of the prior contacts were with DFS, followed by 19% with the Juvenile Court.

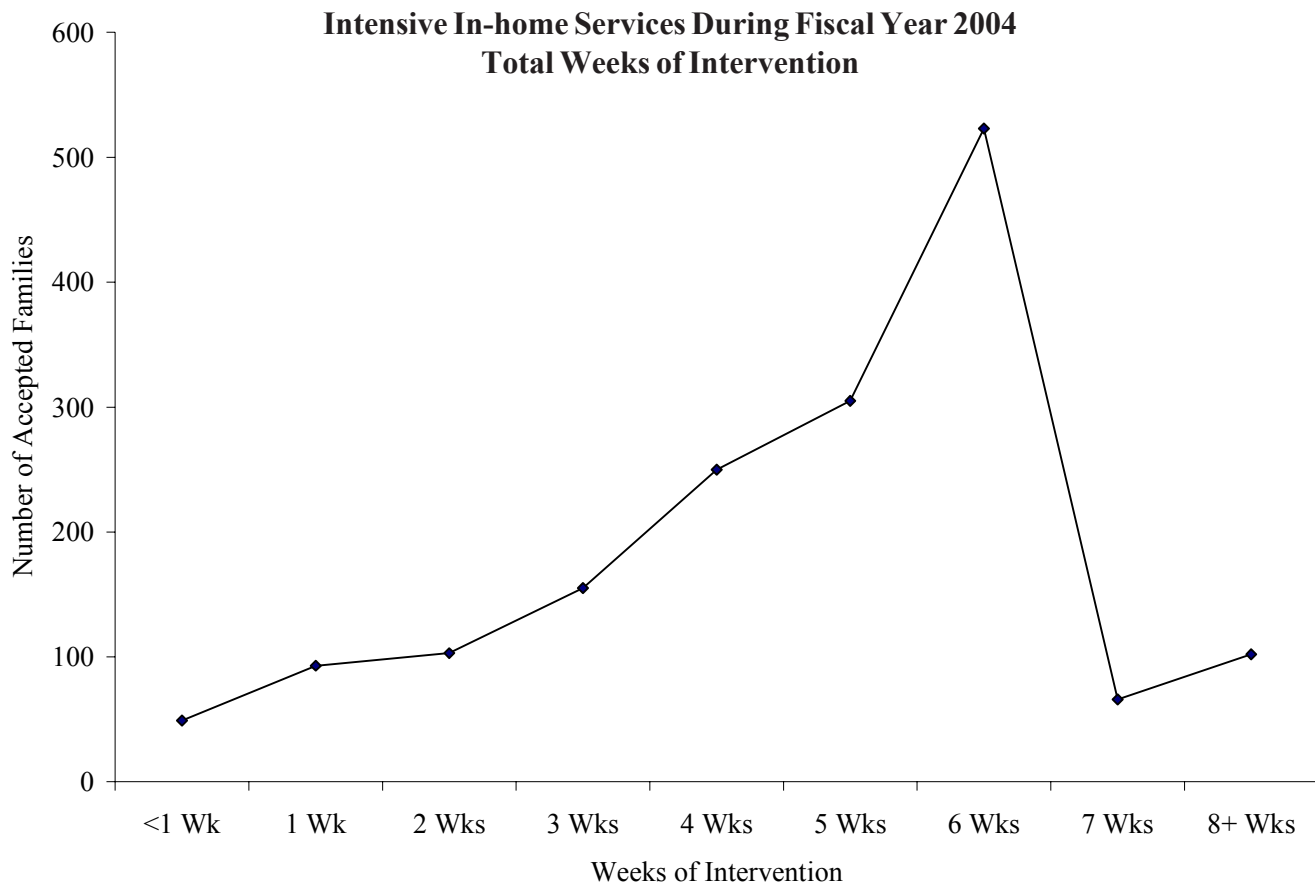
Response Time

Total Weeks of Intervention

During FY 2004, almost 90 percent of families exited IIS within six weeks of acceptance into the program. The average length of intervention was 5.10 weeks.



Families and At-risk Children Exiting

Families and children who leave IIS during the fiscal year are considered to exit in one of the following categories: family intact, family not intact and other. Families are not intact if one of the following occurs: Child Ran Away, Child Moved Out of Home (not placed), Child Living with Relative or Guardian (not Court Ordered), Child Living with Relative or Guardian (Court Ordered), In Foster Home or Group Home, In Residential Treatment, With Division of Youth Services (DYS), In Juvenile Justice and In In-Patient Psychiatric Diversion. Other includes the following: Can't Locate Family, Information Not Available and Other. During FY 2004, 86 percent (1,355) of 1,577 families and 88 percent (2,756) of 3,130 at-risk children exiting IIS were reported to be in intact families (Appendix N).

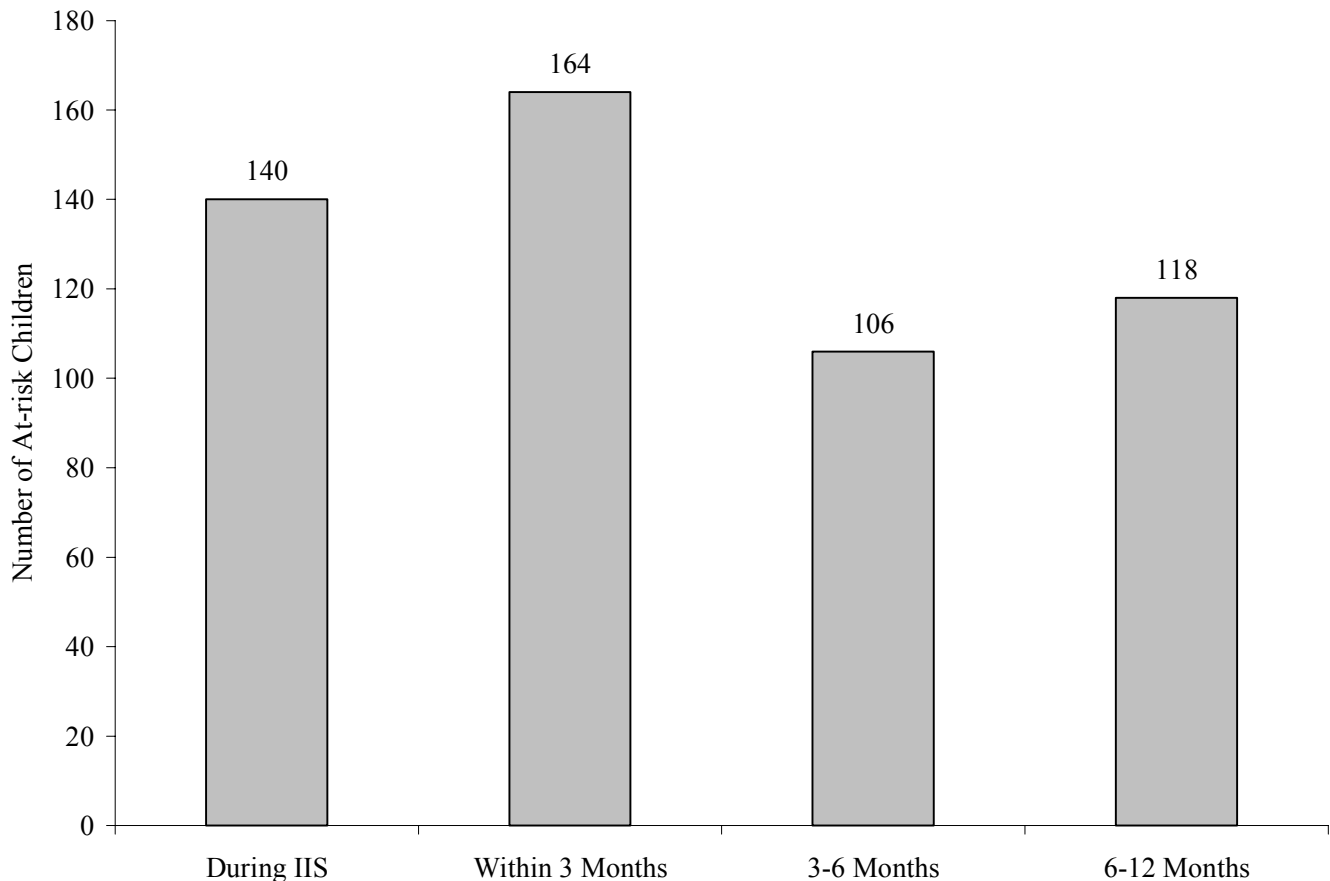
Outcomes

IIS outcome measures can be used to see if the goal of keeping a family safely together after the IIS intervention has been met. These outcome measures include checking to see if a child enters CD or DYS alternative care or is listed as a victim of a substantiated child abuse/neglect hotline

Children who exited IIS during FY 2003 were checked to see if they had entered CD or DYS custody or if they were a victim of a substantiated child abuse/neglect hotline during IIS intervention or within 12 months of exiting IIS. FY 2003 exits were used to give all the children exiting enough time to see if the events had occurred.

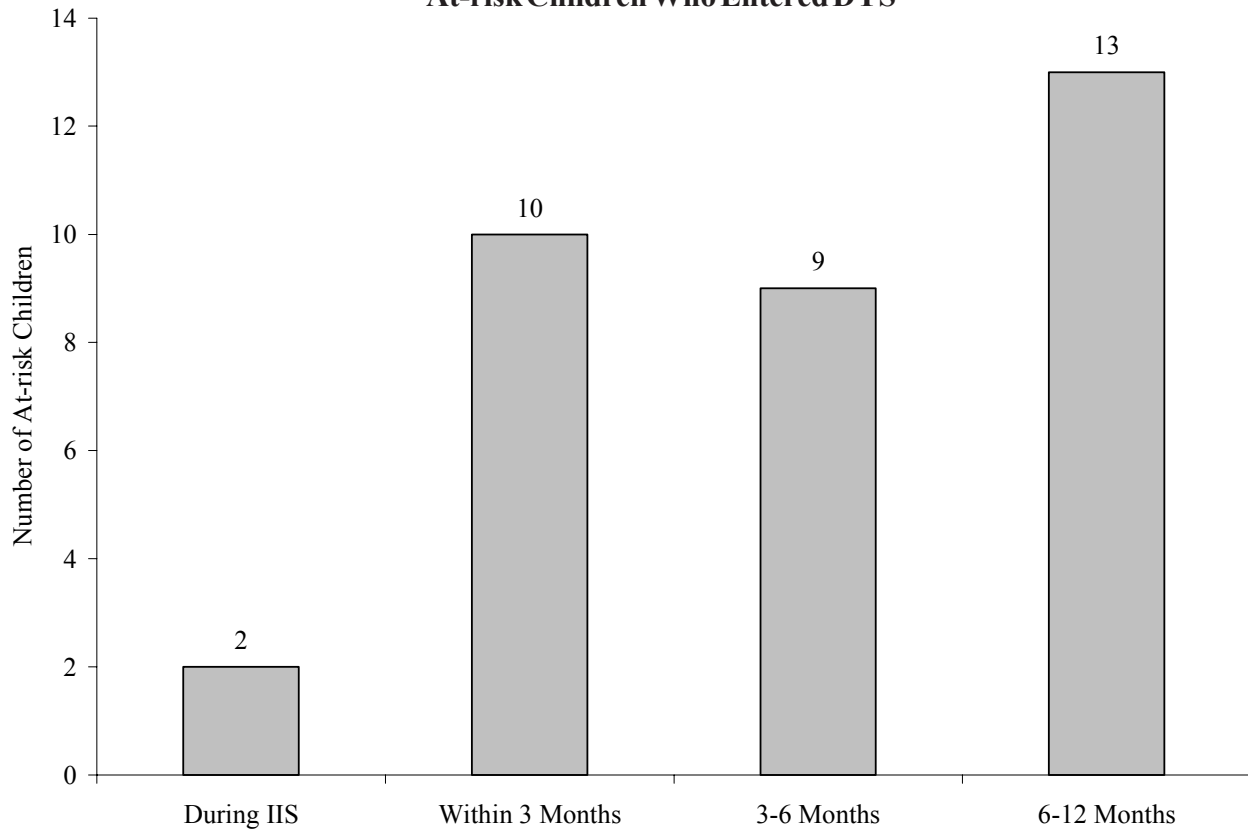
During FY 2003, 3,139 at-risk children exited IIS. Tracking those children during the IIS intervention and for the 12 months following the exit of their IIS intervention, 17% (528) entered CD custody and one percent (34) entered DYS custody. Nine percent (277) of the children were victims of substantiated child abuse/neglect.

At-risk Children Who Entered CD Alternative Care**

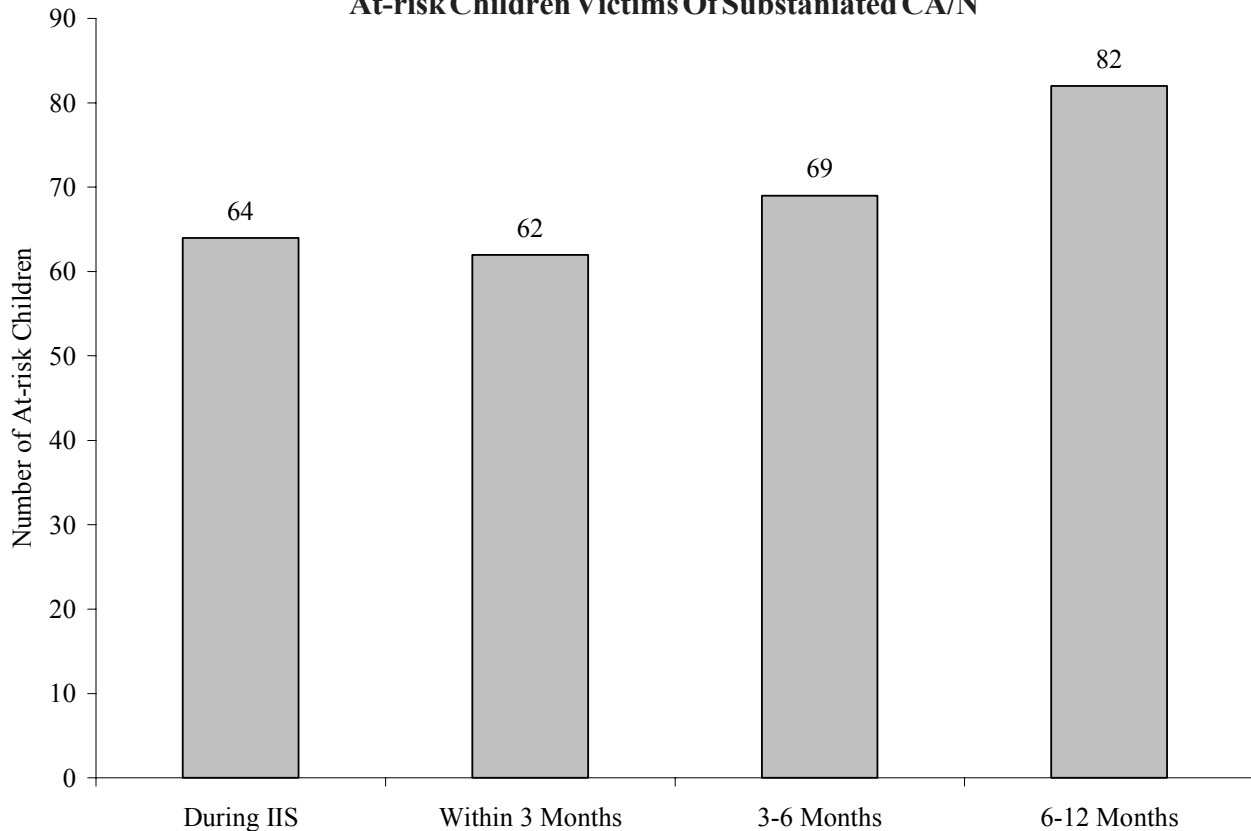
