Get Prepared to Interview Onsite

- Make sure you have two forms of valid, unexpired identification (i.e. drivers/non-driver's license, water bill, electric bill, passport, birth certificate)

The Event

- ✓ Arrive during event times, be prepared, remove distractions, and be patient
- ✓ Bring copies of your resume
- ✓ Answer the interviewees questions thoughtfully
- ✓ Be prepared to accept an offer, or ask the employer when they need a response

The Follow-Up

- Make a list of the roles and companies that interest you most
- Apply online and follow-up within one week
